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

# **FAKE BOOZE**

Boston, Nov. 27-Rhode Island, par ticularly Providence, is the headquar ters of a nationally organized gang of liquor runners and bottled in bond label counterfeiters, while the distri buting point for much of the work is at New Bedford, according to state ments of Federal prohibition agents, who yesterday seized hundreds of quarts of alcohol and thousands of counterfeit bottled in bond labels in the two cities

Providence is believed to be the distributing centre for much bona fide bottled in bond whiskey, thousands of quarts of which have been stolen from warehouses all over the country and smuggled into that city.

In New Bedford more than fort agents in a series of whirlwind raids last night seized liquor valued at more than \$4,000 and unearthed what they believe is the distributing centre fo the counterfeit labels and revenue stamps. The agents seized in one ho tel 200 fake Government stamps and forty-nine gallons of moonshine in bot tles, each bearing a counterfeit Gov ernment stamp and seal.

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
