TESTED RECIPES.

THIN CHOCOLATE COOKIES.

Cream together one-third cupful but er or substitute, one-half cupful sugar, one square melted chocolate and one-half teaspoonful vanilla. Add one and one-half tablespoons milk and work in one cup flour mixed with one teaspoon baking powder and one-half teaspoon salt. Add half a cup more of flour to make the mixture thick enough to roll; chill and divide in halves. Roll very thin, cut with a small cutter, and bake in a moderate oven

SNOW CAKE.

One cup sugar, one-quarter cup but ered creamed together. Break in two whites of eggs, without previous beatng, and whip it till it is a creamy mixture. A great deal of beating is required with this cake, and this, of course, is why it has such a fine grain. Ad dlemon or almond flavoring thoroughly again and add one and one half cups pastry flour and one and one-half teaspoons baking powder Beat the mixture once more and bake in a hot oven in layer-cake tins, or in a loaf if desired, till it leaves the sides of the pans.

### CLEAN SILVER.

Silver that is seldom used may be aid away between folds of oiled paper and so made to keep its shine. Then, when you need extra silver, you will not have to stop to polish it be fore it is fit to grace your table. A few pieces of camphor gum sprinkled among pieces of silver kept in boxes serve the same purpose.
