Spice Drop Cake.

Two eggs, one cup brown sugar, one
cup molasses, three-fourths cup leaf
lard, one cup hot water, two teaspoons
soda, three cups flour, one and a half
teaspoons baking powder, cinnamon
or allspice to taste.

Add soda to hot water and pour
over sugar molasses and lard. Beat
eggs and add. Sift baking powder with
flour and add. Bake in gem tins in
medium oven.

Coffee Ginger Cakes.

Beat an egg in a mixing bowl and
stir into it a cupful of molasses, three
tablespoonfuls of melted shortening
two tablespoonfuls of ginger a tea-
spoonful of cinnamon a teaspoonful
of soda and a half cupful of boiling
coffee. Then beat in one and three-
fourths cupfuls of sifted flour, trans-
fer to a well-oiled dripping pan, and
bake. Serve warm with butter, or hot
or cold with whipped cream, which
has been sweetened with a little hon-
ey and flavored with a few drops of
elmon juice.

Toronto, June 16—Canadian straw-
berries were received yesterday on
the local fruit market for the first
time, in any quantity, this season, and
dealers were asking 45 cents a box for
them. The shipment consisted of some
25 to 35 crates and the berries were
said to have been of very fair quality.

per case.

Old potatoes were lower at \$6 to

were easier, being quoted at \$2.50 to
\$3.

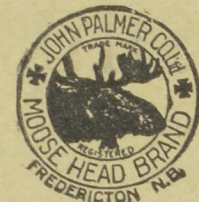

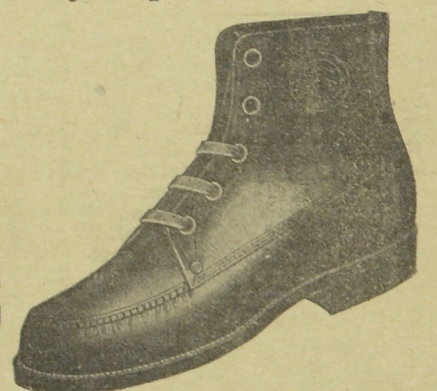
