

Plumes can be curled by a profes sional, or if you have time and patience you can curl them satisfactoril by curling one frond at a time over the blunt end of a nail file.

Velvets of all kinds can be steamed 532 Queen Street, Fredericton, N. B. by placing a wet cloth on a hot iron and drawing the velvet back and fourth over the wet cloth, back towards the cloth and iron, and nap out. If the velvet is not open and flat you can hold it over steam and then brush it carefully one way of the nap to clean and freshen it.

Black lace is part of the summer hats of some women. The best way to clean this is to wash it in black coffee to every cup of which one table spoon of ammonia has been added Rinse in another bath of coffee ,this time clear. If you wish to, add a little arrowroot to the second bath.

Then stretch the lace on an ironing board and pin it into shape. Net and tulle may be washed in the same way


