U. N. AGAINST MT. ALLISON AT SACKVILLE

First Intercollegiate Match Tonight — Williams Will
Play Against Acadia
But Not M. A.

The hockey team of the University of New Brunswick left last night for Sackville where tonight the team will play the opening game of the Western Intercollegiate Hockey League against Mt. Allison University. Wednesday night the U. N. B. team will play Acadia at Wolfville in the second match of the league. This will end U. N. B. games on foreign ice the rest of the matches being played here.

The U. N. B. team will be the same as that which defeated St. Stephen here 7 to 2. It will be, McKenzie, goal Shea, point; Jewett, coverpoint; Fleet Centre; Burgess, Right Wing; Lounsbury, Left Wing; Substitutes, Somers, Lindsay, Hagerman.

This team will go up against Mt. Allison. Archie Williams will play against Acadia at Wolfville. Mount A. has objected to special students being played and Williams is barred, otherwise he would be on at point. Acadia has not offered objection to special students.

Nothing can be forecasted as to the strength of either Mt. Allison or Acadia or the outcome of these games.

Coach J. G. B. Pugh accompanied the squad.

AUSTRALIAN LIGHTWEIGHT IS AFTER LEONARD

Edwards on Way to United States With Tom Andrews as Manager.

New York, Feb. 2—Llew Edwards the lightweight champion of Australia is on his way to this country in tow of Tom Andrews the Milwaukee promoter. Edwards, we learn is coming here for the express purpose of getting a match with Benny Leonard. Since the world's title holder is having a hard time getting anybody to give him even the semblance of a fight, it should be no task to obtain a match with him. As for a fight to a decision with the championship at stake, that is another matter. It remains to be seen if Leonard will jeopardise the title. From what we hear of Edwards he is a rugged battler with a fair punch. He was outpointed for eight rounds by Eddie Wallace, but the Brooklyn man was worn down and stopped in the thirteenth. Indications are that Leonard need not entertain any fears from the direction of Edwards. But there is no question that the arrival of the Australian will create a great deal of talk and develop a lot of comparisons, and for the first time since he won the title from Freddie Welsh Leonard will be confronted with an undeniable challenge to defend the world's honors. We hope that he will see fit to respond to the challenge in the proper way. No American who ever went to Australia was refused a fight—twenty rounds to a decision.

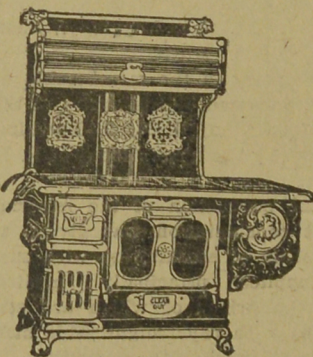

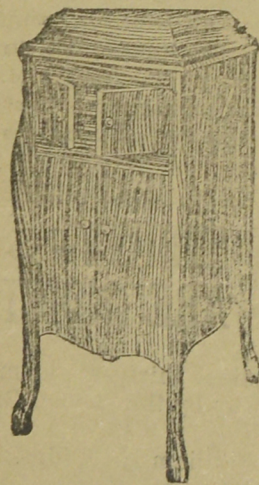
