## FREDERICTON HIGH TOOK LEAD IN THE LEAGUE

Beat Rothesay Here Saturday Two Tries to Nil—The Locals Had Tight Defense.

Fredericton High took the lead in the Interscholastic Rugby Football League Saturday, by defeating Rothesay Collegiate two tries to nil at the University Field Saturday afternoon. The score 6 to 0 indicates the respective merits of the two teams. The local team played a defensive game which the Blue and White could not solve and took advantage of every opening which Rothesay allowed.

Several hundred people went to see the game and the weather could not have been better, except that the bright sun troubled the back division defending the north goal.

### First Half

The first half of Saturday's game saw play very even as far as territory went. Referee J. B. McNair penalized both teams heavily. Offsides and picking out of the scrum drew many, free kicks. Rothesay had the advantage of weight and controlled the ball in the scrum pretty well. This let the Blue and Black halves get away often but the sharp tackling of the Yellow and Black offset that, although low tackling was conspicuous by its absence. Late in the period the local team took advantage of a slip by Rothesay and scored. Cain blocked a kick. Flood dribbled over the Rothesay goal-line and Davidson fell on the ball for a try. Davidson failed to convert.

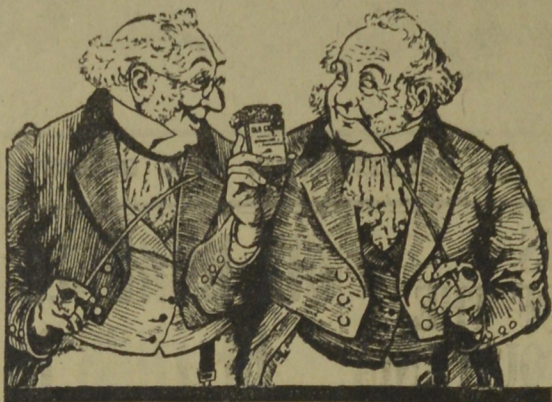
### Second Half

The second half opened with Fredericton High attacking and pressing Rothesay to its line. A free kick enabled Rothesay to relieve and loose forward play let the ball reach mid-field. The Rothesay halves who were being fed with the ball regularly got away on short runs and play soon was inside the Fredericton High twenty-five. There was a long kick to the Rothesay backs. Soon after Scammell got the ball and went through the Fredericton team. He looked good for a try until Hickson tackled him and McCaffrey followed back and assisted. This was the nearest Rothesay came to scoring. On a free kick shortly afterward, Rothesay spoiled another good chance by kicking over the Fredericton High goal-line, Hickson touching down.

The drop-out was run back by Rothesay, but for a loss. Rothesay continued on the offensive. The value of sharp tackling was shown by the Fredericton back division. The Rothesay scrum was heeling well and only the hard defensive work of the local team saved a score. Rothesay finally slackened and the Yellow and Black gradually took the play down the field on short runs and forward dribbling. The ball went into touch near the Rothesay twenty-five. Daggett was playing right next the touch-line and took the ball on the throw-out. He was not marked and getting away ran along the touch-line and scored in the corner. McCaffrey failed to convert. Time expired within a few seconds.
