Winnipeg, Feb. 26-William Ivens was declared guilty of contempt of court by a full court of the King's Bench today anl was bound over for three months under a bond of \$1,000 on his own undertaking, to refrain from further criticism of the court. In rendering the decision the court declared Ivens had "scandalized the court and Mr. Justice Metcalfe and had prejudiced the state trial now being heard."

Ivens' conviction was based on a speech he made December 28 at a he declared "Bob Russell was tried by a poisoned judge, a poisoned jury and was the victim of a poisoned sentence.'
