FRANK MILLER SECURED BY THE BRAVES

John Paul Jones Also Will Report—Neither Pitcher Will be in Shape for the Opening.

Columbus, Ga., March 21.—Frank Miller, a right handed pitcher, has been bought from the Pittsburg Club by President Grant of the Braves.

Grant announced the completion of the deal yesterday. Miller is a big fellow standing six feet. He is about 30 years old, and Manager Stallings says he is a fine pitcher. With the Pirates last season he won 14 games and lost 11. It is hoped that Miller will report to the club at once.

Right on the heels of a telegram from John Paul Jones, saying that he would not play ball under any conditions this season, came another saying that he had accepted terms and would report at the training camp Saturday.

While this is an important addition to the pitching staff, neither Miller nor Jones will be able to get into condition to take part in the early games of the series with the Detroit club, the first game of which is to be played in Columbus Tuesday.

TO LAUNCH A NEW STEAMER NEXT WEEK

Montreal, March 20.—The new Cunard Liner Scythia is to be launched from the yard of Vickers, Limited, Barrow-in-Furness, England on the 23rd instant.

This steamer is 600 feet long, beam 73½ feet, depth 45 feet, gross tonnage 21,000, speed 16 knots. She will have accommodation for 2,500 passengers and is fitted with turbine engines developing about 12,500 shaft horse power. She is an oil burner, the fuel being carried in her double bottom.

The Scythia will possess several new features, including two garden lounges, verandah cafe for the sole use of cabin passengers and in both saloons and cabin dining rooms the old fashioned long tables will be replaced by smaller tables, sitting two, four and six people.

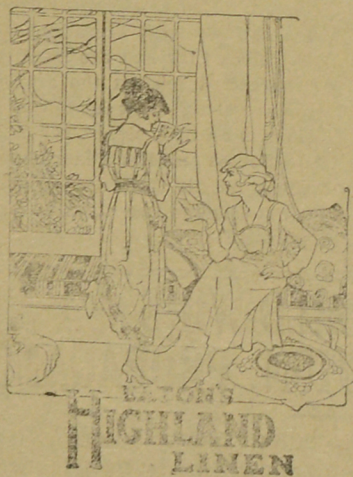
FORAN TO FACE PUCK TONIGHT
