

OF INTEREST TO  
THE WOMEN

FURS MORE POPULAR  
IN PARIS THIS YEAR.

First cold days are bringing about a great revival of the fur coat. Not that it was ever very much removed from the limelight, but there was probably never a winter when the fur coat was so generalized.

The distinguishing feature of it this winter is the rolled shawl collar, replacing the high square one of the past seasons. It rolls high in the back, tinning down to a low waistline in the front. There is also a tendency to the flare which is so popular but straight lines will also be worn. The flare has one big thing against it when it comes to adding it to a fur coat; that is, it greatly increases the weight and that is one thing no woman wants—a heavy fur coat. A light silky fur like moleskin is well enough for the flare, and fine mink can be worked into most intricate designs.

This year is seeing a greater demand for mink coats than ever before, in spite of their costliness. They are usually worked like sables, the skins being dropped with no cross joins visible. Brown furs are in the lead, but gray squirrel also shows much favor. Natural gray kimmer, which is rather rare is also good for certain types.

Combinations of two or more kinds of fur are being made by all the smart houses. Nutria is worked into loutre in a fancy design and black caracul most often goes with kolinsky. One very smart coat seen at the races had the lower part of the skirt in kolinsky running to a point reaching the shoulders in the back. Persian lamb is trimmed with mink, beaver or kolinsky and summer ermine in a light fawn color on a sealskin coat carries out the idea of combining light and dark furs. Light gray fox trims a black coat. Cubist cloaks have two kinds of fur one for the collar and the other for a wide hem.

## THE OYSTER IN VARIOUS GUISES.

Oyster stew and oysters on the half shell are among the housewife's standbys. But there are many cooks whose knowledge of the oyster stops right there. They have no idea of the many other delicious ways in which it can be prepared. And now that such strict government regulations regarding the care and maintenance of the oyster beds are in force the public is assured of a perfectly safe product so that the old bugaboo which formerly attached itself to the oyster is quite forgotten.

## Deviled Oysters.

Chop two dozen oysters very fine. Place in saucepan with 1 teaspoon melted butter and 1-2 cup cream or rich milk. Season with cayenne pepper and salt and add 1-2 cup rolled cracker crumbs. Simmer five minutes, stirring gently. Put in baking dish, sprinkle top with finely sifted dried bread crumbs and bits of butter. Bake until rich golden brown.

## Oyster Fritters.

Chop twenty-four small oysters and add one and a quarter cups flour, one teaspoonful baking powder, half teaspoonful salt, quarter teaspoon paprika and yolks of two eggs. Mix thoroughly and fold in whites of eggs beaten stiff. Cook in hot cooking oil, drain and serve. If you prefer to use small oysters whole add to your dry ingredients three-quarters cup milk, allowing two oysters to each fritter.



## A BIG DRIVE BEING PLANNED FOR FUNDS

Truro, Nov. 22—Rev. Dr. J. W. McConnell, the secretary of the committee of direction of the Maritime Conference of the United Church, announced in Truro today that in most of the 1,300 congregations of the conference the canvass for the maintenance and extension fund of the church would begin this week. Of the four millions that the church was expected to raise, the sum of \$375,000 had been allocated to the Maritime Conference. This in turn had been allocated to the 17 presbyteries constituting the conference, he said. Dr. McConnell reported that throughout the conference there was a splendid spirit of optimism as the church faced the task.
