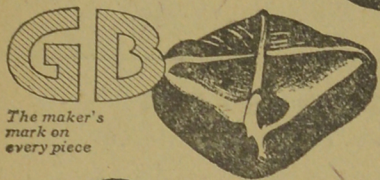

PINEAPPLE SAGO.

2 cups pineapple
1 cup sago
1-2 cup sugar
1-2 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon lemon juice

Wash the sago and soak in 4 cups cold water for 2 hours; put over fire in the same water and boil very slowly 2 hours or until clear stirring occasionally. Add the sugar salt and lemon juice; simmer 1 hour. Pour into glass bowl, or ice cream glasses. When very cold serve with whipped cream; garnish with small pieces of tart red jelly.

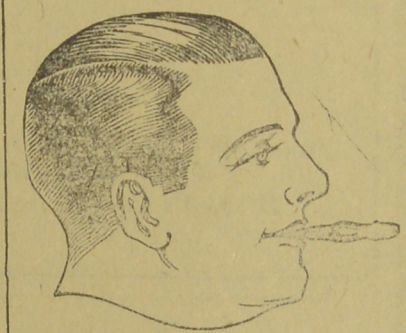
PINEAPPLE HONEY.

3 cups grated pineapple
2 cups sugar
2 teaspoons lemon juice

Wash and cut the pineapple into quarters (skins are used for syrup) or wash, pare and put through food chopper. To each 3 cups of fruit put 2 cups of sugar (1 pound) and if the pineapple is very sweet add 3 teaspoons lemon juice, but if tart no lemon is needed. Put fruit and sugar in saucepan and boil slowly until it has thickened, stirring constantly. It takes from 45 minutes to 1 hour.

FILET OF FLOUNDER OR TROUT SAUCE TARTAR.

Flounder, 1 egg 1 cup breadcrumbs
1 teaspoon salt
1-2 teaspoon white pepper
Split and remove all bone and skin from flounder; cut in pieces about 2x3 inches; wash and dry on piece of cheesecloth; dust with salt and pepper; dredge with flour; dip in egg which has been beaten with 1 tablespoon of cold milk then in breadcrumbs. Fry in deep, hot fat. The sauce tartar is made as follows:

1 cup mayonnaise
1 tablespoon finely chopped olives
1 tablespoon sour gherkins
1 tablespoon onion juice

Be sure the mayonnaise is seasoned highly. Just before serving add the other ingredients mix and serve in sauce boat.

RICE MOULD WITH STRAWBERRIES.

1-2 cup rice
2 cups crushed strawberries
Sugar to taste
1-2 cup milk
1 teaspoon butter
1-2 teaspoon salt
Dash of grated nutmeg or a few drops of vanilla

Wash and boil the rice 20 minutes; drain (do not blanch); put into top of double boiler with the milk 1-4 cup sugar, nutmeg or vanilla and salt and boil slowly 20 minutes. The rice must absorb all the milk. Brush four custard cups with melted butter, fill with the rice and set in refrigerator until cold. Turn out on saucedish and cover with the crushed strawberries to which sugar has been added.

JUNKED MOTOR CARS HELP TO TAME A RIVER

Pierr, S. D., June 11—Junked motor cars are being put to a new use here—that of helping to "tame" the Missouri river.

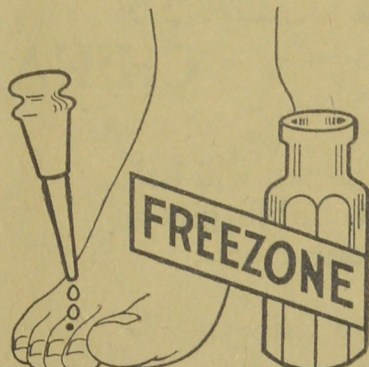

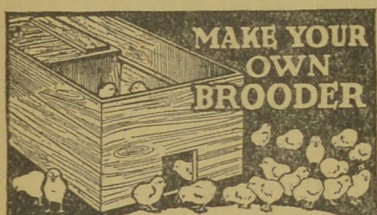
