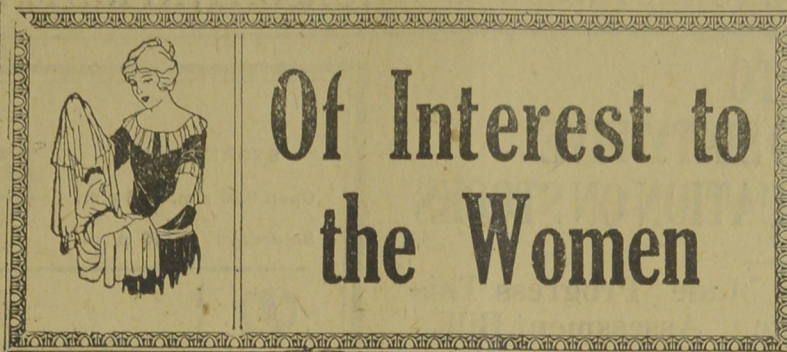

the WomenWAYS TO SERVE SMOKED FISH
TEMPTINGLY.Codfish "A La New England" Makes
Tasty Main Dish For Dinner.

There are times when nothing seems so tempting to the appetite as salt or smoked fish. It can be prepared in several ways and there are numerous preparations from which to make a choice. Smoked mackerel, finnan haddie (haddock), salt codfish, smoked and kippered herring and smoked halibut are favorites. Codfish makes a good main dish for a dinner when prepared in old New England style, but the other varieties are best for breakfast, suppers or luncheons. In England kippered herring is a specialty for breakfasts coming next to bacon and eggs in popularity. Finnan haddie when baked in milk is delicate. Smoked mackerel is perhaps the richest of all the smoked fish, since it is one of the richest of fresh fish.

New England codfish dinner is best when made from boned and dried pieces of fish and not from shredded fish. Do not flake the fish, but soak it in cold water and for two hours. Put in fresh cold water and simmer for ten minutes after bringing to a boil slowly. Change the water and simmer for ten minutes after bringing to a boil slowly. Change the water and simmer again, this time until it is tender but does not fall apart. Lay the stripes of fish on a platter and arrange plain boiled potatoes around the edges. Garnish with watercress or parsley. Serve with cubes of salt pork tried out in a pan, using both the liquid fat and the cubes. With this for the main dish serve buttered beets and spinach and the dinner will be satisfying. A hearty dessert is good with this dinner such as apple dumplings with lemon sauce, squash or mince pie, etc.

Kippered herring and mackerel are tasty when pan broiled, though each may be broiled on a gridiron if preferred. Care must be taken not to burn the dry skin when that side is next the flame if broiled over a fire. Serve the kippers plain but the mackerel with maitre d'hotel sauce made as follows: Mix two level tablespoons of butter with three tablespoons of flour. Mix with a little cold milk and stir vigorously into two cups of scalding hot milk. Cook until thickened and smooth. Season with pepper and a dash of celery salt, but do not put in any ordinary salt. Pour this over mackerel or smoked salmon or halibut which has been soaked in cold water until tender. Put the sauce around the fish, not over it. Lay slices of hard-boiled egg on top of the fish. This served with mashed or French fried potatoes and Brussels sprouts or baked cabbage, au gratin, makes a luncheon dish that is "different." It may even be served for a dinner if followed by a rather hearty salad and a substantial dessert such as plum pudding, fruit baba, etc.

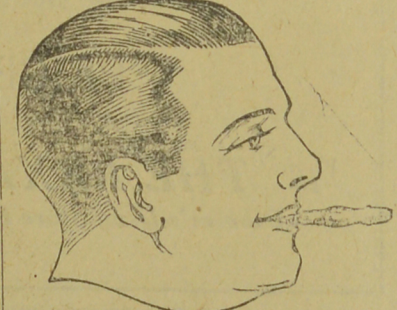

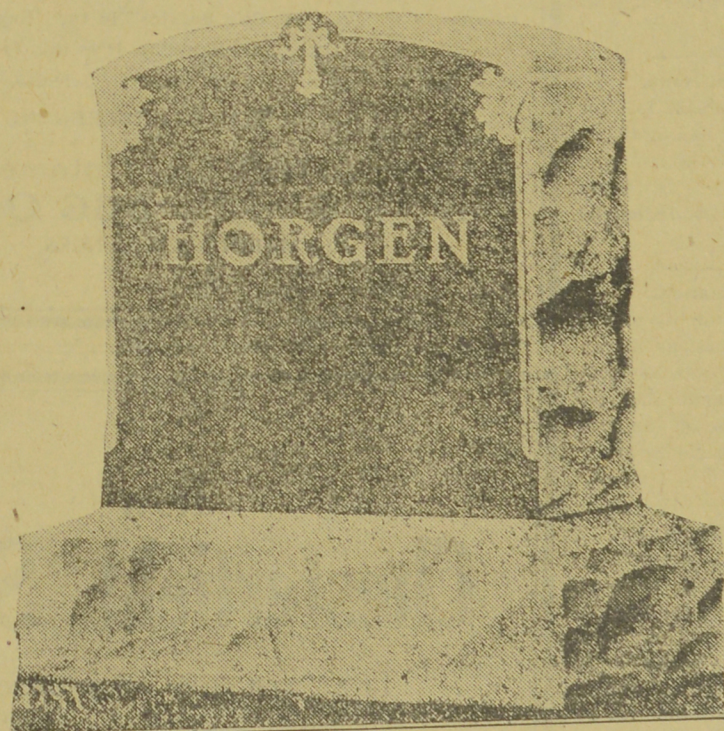
