## OF INTEREST TO THE WOMEN

DETAILS OF FASHION  
GLIMPSED IN SALONS  
AND RESTAURANTS.

New York—A new style of pajama has velvet trousers with an over blouse of finely pleated georgette.

A Poiret frock of striking appearance has a waist of heavy crochet which joins a gathered skirt just below the waist line. Straps cross the shoulders just at their points and two or three inches below the shoulders begin the long, tight sleeves also of the crochet.

A nutria coat seen recently was trimmed with strips of brown suede.

On a tight fitting little black hat is a small silver frame worn as ornament, which is supposed to contain a photograph of the wearer's fiancée. A felt lap falling over the frame conceals it from the unsympathetic eye.

The new tunic is bell shaped. It is used in a two piece evening dress which combines gold fringe and ivory panne velvet.

An odd frock by Nancy is of white silk serge. It is box pleated from the shoulder to the hip, the pleats held down by strips of hand fagoting, which also trims the cuffs and small collar.

The jumper of a two piece frock has a group of fine pleats falling from the breast pockets, giving it a full effect.

A turban of black satin achieves a high crown by a coiled effect looking much like a satin rose its center at the highest point of the crown.

Black silk that imitates monkey fur has an effect of drooping hair given by fine silk fringe which covers the entire surface. It was used for a large scarf and for the skirt of a two piece evening gown.

## MY NEIGHBOR SAYS.

Before removing a soiled table cloth and napkins look for fruit stains and put camphor on them, then wash the same as any white goods.

A kettle holder to which is attached about a yard of tape is very useful when one is working in the kitchen. Tie the tape to your waistline and then the kettle holder will be ready at hand whenever you want to take anything hot from the stove.

To dye white shirts khaki, dissolve few cents' worth of permanganate of potash in half a pint of boiling water. Then add to a basin of hot water. Put the shirt in the basin and keep moving it about with a stick till it is the desired color, then take out, dry and iron.

## STUFFING FOR CHICKEN.

Remove the crust from a baker's loaf of old bread (if the chicken is large, it will require a large sized loaf), slice and pick into small bits; season with one and one-half teaspoon of salt, one fourth teaspoon spoon of poultry seasoning; add one soon of poultry seasoning; add one medium sized onion chopped fine and mix thoroughly using two forks. Melt one-half cup of butter or margarine in two-thirds cup of boiling water, add gradually to the mixture and toss lightly until well blended; then add one large or two small eggs slightly beaten; mix well and use as directed. If the bread is very stale, more moisture may be added.

## KU KLUX KLAN OR NOT KU KLUX KLAN

(Toronto Globe, editorial.)

That is the question facing Canada: whether 'tis nobler to ignore the white-shrouded, night-riding gentry, or by opposing end them. British Columbia has requested Federal action outlawing the Ku Klux Klan, while hereabouts we merely shrug our shoulders and laugh at their mummery and antics. Yet the craze to wear the sheets and pillowcase, and execute the coo-coo can-can around a flaming cross, is not a healthy sign. The Klan aims at establishing a super-government to enable its cowardly members, under cover of darkness, secrecy, anonymity, and a surprise attack by overpoweringly superior numbers, to gratify their spite against some defenseless individual in defiance of the constitutional guarantee that no one shall suffer injury in person or property without due process of law. And the obvious danger inherent in such an organization is the obvious danger inherent in all militaristic establishments, namely, that innocent victims will be sacrificed to the mere blood-lust of the hungry and ruthless monster when it becomes too powerful to be contented with idleness.

Some two and a half centuries ago Louis XIV., a French King, built up such an absolute despotism that he arrogantly proclaimed, "L'Etat, c'est moi": "I am the State, the commonwealth, the country." Naturally, the result of this, two or three generations later, was communism, the guillotine, The Terror. A few months ago in the State of Indiana across the line, a former Grand Dragon of the Klan reached the point of declaring, "I am the law." Probably most of us hereabouts consider this conception of legality and justice inferior to the British theory law and order, but we may have to take vigorous action to resist it, for parading in night-gowns seems to exercising an overwhelming lure for the feeble-minded. Yet, surely, Canada is a far finer word—and thing—than Klanada.

## MUSSOLINI TO MAKE ROME A WONDER CITY

Rome, Jan. 4.—Within five years, said Mussolini at the ceremony of inauguration of the first Governor of Rome today, Rome must become the most wonderful city in the world in the eyes of the people of the globe. "My ideas are clear," he added, "my orders are precise, and I am sure they soon will be translated into concrete facts. Vast, well ordered, powerful as in the days of the first Empire or Augustus, Rome must again become a wonder of the world."

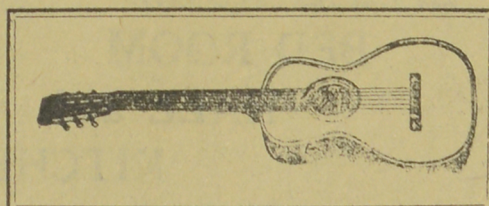
