



FRUIT WHIP.

In planning a dessert it is a good thing to take into consideration what has preceded it in the dinner menu. For instance, if the meal has already had sufficient starchy things do not have a starchy dessert. Contrive a fruity one instead. Fruit whip for instance. Two cups of the liquid fruit uices into which has been poured a mixture made from 1 tablespoon gelatin dissolved in 1 tablespoon hot water. 




