FRUIT WHIP.

In planning a dessert it is a good thing to take into consideration what has preceded it in the dinner menu. For instance, if the meal has already had sufficient starchy things do not have a starchy dessert. Contrive a fruity one instead. Fruit whip for instance.

Two cups of the liquid fruit juices into which has been poured a mixture made from 1 tablespoon gelatin dissolved in 1 tablespoon hot water. Pour this over the well beaten whites of 2 eggs, and then have ready a bowl in which you have cut up 2 oranges, 2 bananas about four halves canned peaches (when fresh are not obtainable) a few strawberries (only a few, as they are quite in the millionaire class at present) and a half cup of canned cherries. Into this fruit mixture pour the gelatine mixture, which may have a tablespoon or two of sugar but which is sweet enough for most persons without and allow to cool.

Dissolve a dozen marshmallows in double boiler add to whites of 2 eggs, and serve on top of the fruit whip.

TUTTI FRUTTI RICE PUDDING.

Two cups cooked rice, one cup nuts, one cup raisins, half cup dried figs, quarter teaspoon cinnamon three tablespoons honey, one dozen candied cherries, one cup sweet milk, two eggs and whipped cream for top.

Chop the nuts, raisins and figs and stir into the milk and honey. Beat the yolks and whites of the eggs separately and into the yolks beat the rice. Next mix in the fruits and nuts, next the cinnamon and lastly the beaten whites of the eggs. Bake about a quarter of an hour and serve cold with whipped cream and candied cherries on top.


