Entries for Fredericton's Midsummer Harness Races close today which means that mail entries will be accepted up to noon Tuesday. Secretary D. W. Griffiths of the Fredericton Driving and Sporting Club expects large lists. They will be published this week.

Wednesday and Thursday of next week are the dates, the 28th and 29th. The classes number seven—Free-for-All, 2.10 Pace, 2.13 Trot and Pace, 2.15 Trot, 2.16 Trot and Pace, 2.20 Pace and 2.20 Trot. The Free-for-All has a \$1000 purse hung up and will get all the top liners on the Maine and New Brunswick Circuit. The 2.10 Pace and the 2.13 Mixed Class also will draw notable fields. The purses are \$500 in each. In the other four classes the purses are \$400.

ARTHUR FINNAMORE AGAIN UMPIRE

Saint John, July 19—Oil has been poured on the troubled waters in the Saint John Senior Amateur Baseball League when, at an executive meeting on Saturday with all parties concerned in attendance, Arthur Finnermore, recently dismissed as an umpire was "unanimously reinstated."

A. W. Covey, president of the City League, when approached last evening said that beyond the reinstatement of Finnermore there was nothing to say concerning the meeting. Finnermore, it will be recalled was given his notice some days ago that his services were no longer required as an umpire in the City League, following a verbal altercation he had with Aubrey Snodgrass first sacker of the Water Department team, 1925 Maritime champions and league leaders at the present time, when he (Finnermore) finally ordered Snodgrass out of the game. At an executive meeting of the league held shortly afterwards Finnermore was voted out of office.
