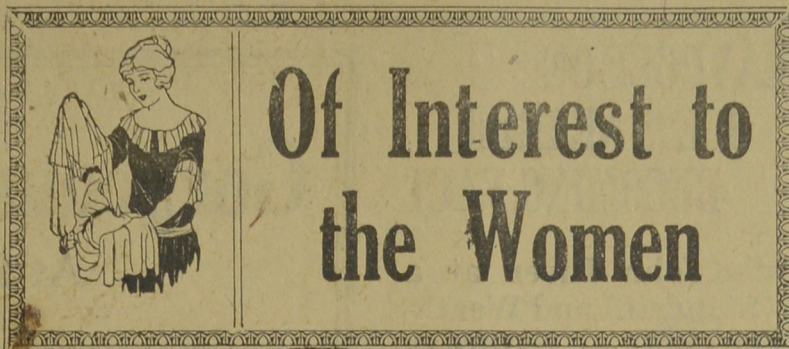

PLAIN COATS IN CAPE STYLES.

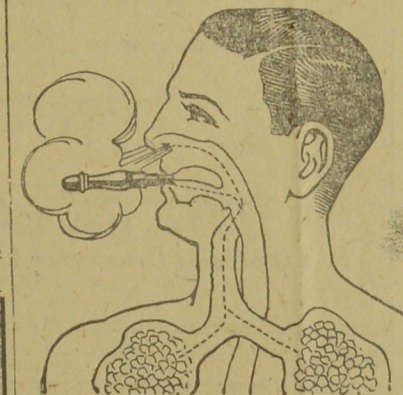

of milk and from one-half to one cup of milk and from one-half to one cup of sugar. Stir into this one cup of rolled and sifted bread crumbs; add the prepared pineapple mix all thoroughly and turn into a deep glass pieplate lined with rich pastry and bake forty-five minutes. Spread with a meringue is desired. Serve cold.

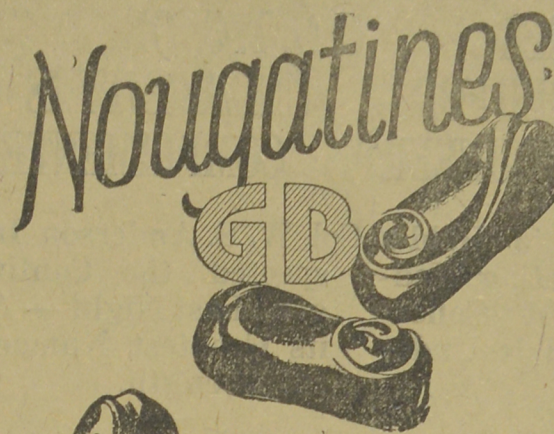
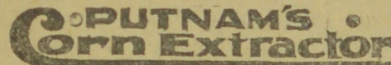
PRUNE CREAM PIE.

Soak one pound of medium-sized prunes in water to cover overnight; cook in the same water until tender, let cool, and remove the stones and cut prunes in halves.

Arrange the prunes in a glass pie-plate lined with rich pastry, add one-half cup of sugar, two tablespoons of butter cut in small bits, the juice of half a lemon, one-fourth teaspoon of salt and enough of the prune liquor to moisten the mixture. Bake in a moderate oven until the pastry is well browned. When cold cover with a meringue of whipped cream sweetened and flavored with vanilla. Chill and serve.
