## Of Interest to the Women

WHO CAN'T BE SMART  
THIS SPRING? CAPES AND  
ENSEMBLES ARE IN!

Capes occupy a most important place in the spring wardrobe, especially as an ensemble. In the many interpretations of the cape model a new silhouette is effected, one which is graceful on almost anyone excepting the extremely stout woman. There is a partiality for the three-quarter length cape, which, used as an ensemble is destined to be most popular in spring for sport afternoon and evening wear. At a recent fashion show a most striking cape ensemble was made of a combination of black and white crepe, mongol. It consisted of a straight line white tunic, the sleeves long and tight, while the undershirt was of black. A bright red cord girdle gave a vivid touch. With this a three-quarter length cape of black was worn, a black satin turban completing the outfit.

Another lovely ensemble was of floral bordered black flat crepe, the border forming an overskirt on the straight line dress. The three-quarter length coat had the border repeated on the sleeves with cuffs and collars of gray fox.

A strawberry colored crepe ensemble showed a dress with embroidered waist and an overskirt formed of self-colored fringe. A three-quarter length cape on simple lines was worn with this.

A lovely evening ensemble had a cape made of two layers of chiffon, pink over flesh, cut circular, full length, with a huge white fox collar. This was worn over a matching pink chiffon evening gown, elaborate by beaded in crystals, the beads forming a fringe at the bottom of the dress. Fringe is exceedingly smart.

A sport ensemble had a finger tip length jumper of white crepe with a band of embroidered pistachio colored kasha at the bottom. The undershirt was of finely pleated kasha, as was the three quarter length coat, which fell from a deep yoke.

The separate cape is also popular. A stunning one for evening was of black chiffon shot with gold, the collar being formed of squirrel tails mounted on bright red chiffon.

A cape for the young girl was of pink taffeta with triple puffed flounces at the bottom and a high puffed collar. An afternoon coat had a deep pointed cape embroidered in white wool and rayon. A deep scarf effect, collar was faced in white satin. For sport, plaids, especially black and white, and checks are most attractive. Novelty buttons and solid colors are the favored forms of trimming for frocks of these designs.

## EGGS HARRISON.

3 hard-boiled eggs  
3 medium sized potatoes  
2 tablespoons butter  
2 tablespoons flour  
1 cup milk  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 tablespoon onion juice  
1-2 teaspoon white pepper  
1 tablespoon parsley.

Boil the potatoes; when tender drain and break apart with a fork. The hard-boiled eggs are cut crosswise, added to the potatoes, covered with the cream sauce, and served. Sprinkle with parsley.

## EGG CUTLET, TOMATO SAUCE.

4 hard-boiled eggs  
1 cup milk  
1 tablespoon butter  
2 tablespoons flour  
1 teaspoon onion juice  
1 tablespoon parsley  
Dash of white pepper  
Dash paprika  
1-2 teaspoon salt

First chop the whites of the eggs fine and add to the cream sauce; add seasonings and mashed yolks spread on a platter and cool. When firm take up one tablespoon in floured hands and shape into oblongs two inches long and one inch thick, making the ends rounded. Dip in egg beaten with one tablespoon of cold milk and then in bread-crumbs; fry in deep fat. Serve hot with tomato sauce.

## Chirred Eggs Flavored With Bacon.

Brush ramekins or custard cups with drippings; put in one tablespoon of finely cut bacon which has been fried until nearly done; break one egg into each cup. Bake in a moderate oven until as firm as desired. Serve at once.

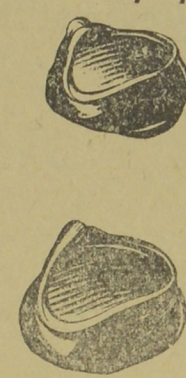

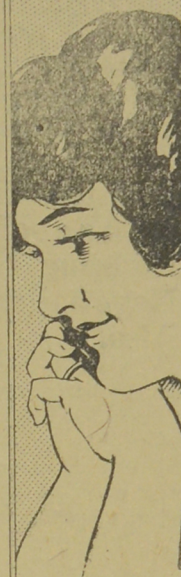

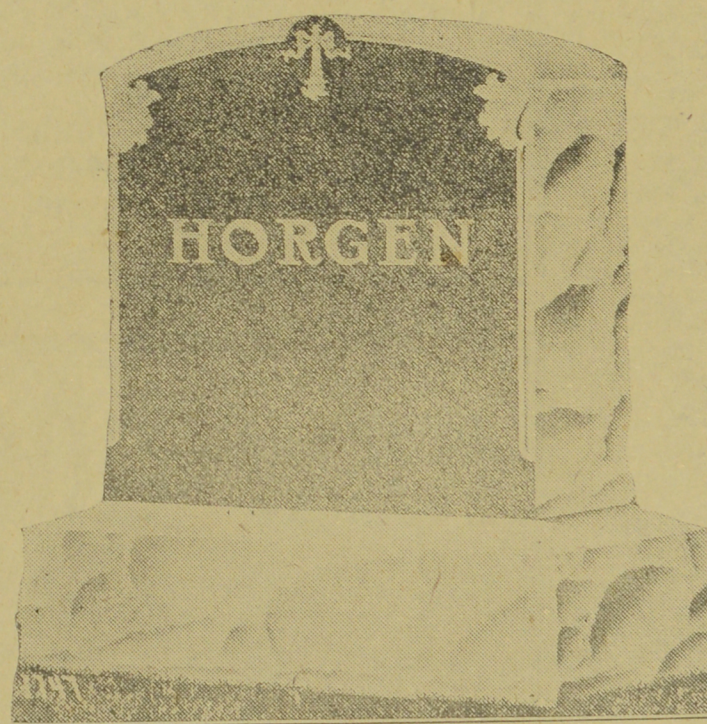
