

## THE BRICK INDUSTRY

A WAY back in the 1870's were the days of real sport in the Clay Working and Brick Making Industry—When the men would take off their boots (if they had any) and get into the clay bins and gug the clay with their feet. The only steam power for turning out the moulded clay was a "one horse power", a big white horse that travelled in a circle whereby a. few thousand brick per day were turned out.

Today the most modern machinery is used, and the Firm cordially invite to their Plant anyone that is interested in home building. A great many people

have the idea that "A brick is only a brick". But when the process is followed from the clay bank to the Crushers and then into the Pugmill and moulding machines, thence onto the carriers into the steam-pipe driers where with 130 deg. of heat are dried for nine hours, they are now ready for the kilns where they are burned to a cherry red color taking seven days and nights with a maximum of 2,000 deg. Fahr. heat, and the last move is from the kilns onto the cars for shipment to all parts of the Province and State of Maine. Really it is very interesting, So, Come Along.



## WHEN BUILDING

- BE SURE the Electric Wiring is properly installed so it will pass the Board of Fire Underwriters' Regulations.
- BE SURE that all Flues are standard, securely built, and will not fall if the building suffers a small fire.
- BE SURE the Furnace is properly installed and that the pipes are securely fastened together and cannot come apart.
- BE SURE that all Pipes from the Furnace are Protected where they are nearer than 18 inches to woodwork.
- BE SURE that all Furnace Pipes, where they pass through floors or partitions, are held in mortar or brick fixtures.
- BE SURE that all Flues are made of brick. Do not Use Stove Pipe.
- BE SURE that you do not hang Electric Light Wires on nails. Use a porcelain knob.
- BE SURE and build your house warm and install a larger furnace than you need, so you will not have to drive the furnace. Overheated pipes cause many a fire.
- BE SURE and Keep Your Premises Clean. Last but not Least—BE SURE and INSURE with,
