## Of Interest to the Women

### VARIATIONS OF COSTUME.

Now that spring is here and the crowds along the avenue are beginning to take on a festive air it is interesting to watch the variations of the tailored costume. For instance, one can hardly take two steps without seeing new and charming cape costumes with the cape either three-quarter length, hip length or in the shorter ones, including those that give a bolero effect.

The two-piece suit of navy blue is increasing in popularity and with it is often worn a brilliantly colored scarf knotted at the throat. Taffeta or some softer material is smart for these scarfs, the only requisite for their chic being a lavish amount of color. They come with hand painted designs, bright solid colors or a large plaid or checked pattern. The small close-fitting hat, of course is the type most seen with these tailors and these take either a draped turn or a low narrow brim turned up in the back. Other details to complete this very smart spring street costume are a silver fox scarf and very high heeled oxfords, the latter either of reptile or some light colored kid. The vogue of the tailored ensemble also evidences itself in the two-quarter length coat which as a rule is seen with some sort of concealed fullness at the waist.

In frequenting the night clubs one is struck by the growing popularity of the bolero or short jacket effect for dance or dinner frocks. This is often seen on beaded gowns and the edges of the short jacket are sometimes scalloped or finished in some uneven fashion and are heavily embroidered with beads or sequins. Sequins, incidentally, are especially in favor now, so much so, in fact that at nearly every place where there is dancing the effect is a scintillating, brilliant one on account of the large number of beaded gowns. Fringe is another item of great importance for frocks for evening wear and is used in a variety of ways, such as around the skirt, in tiered effect, coming in a number of lengths the most popular one being, however from ten to twelve inches.

The jumper is one of the most sponsored types for more informal wear. Particularly when developed in taffeta is it finding favor, two colors of tones of the material being often used. A smart jumper costume seen on Fifth avenue recently was of navy blue taffeta trimmed in red and white checked taffeta the same material also covering the small stubby umbrella that was carried as a smart accessory.

Increasing numbers of evening frocks that are trimmed with bands, either straight or ruffled, of pastel colored tulle, will gladden the hearts of all those who believe in the essentially feminine type of dress. Such frocks are often seen developed in black and pale pink, a combination that is especially good this spring. Tiers of ruffled tulle on the skirt are favored and these are particularly becoming to the unsophisticated type of beauty who has a slim figure and pretty ankles. A wide band of tulle when placed at the bottom of a bouffant dress also gives a charming effect when through it may be seen the daintily shod feet.

In regard to color, it is generally acknowledged that green still continues in the fore. Bois de rose, red, navy blue, and black for evening wear, are some of the colors that are being emphasized both by dressmakers and smartly gowned women. All of these colors are especially chic when trimmed with a darker shade of the same tone.

Of love that looks from youth's enchanted face!

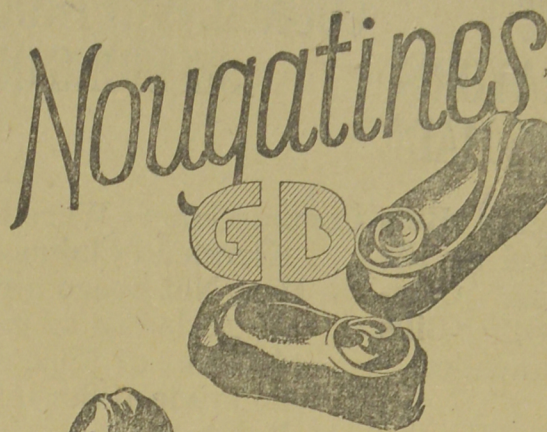
The anthem of the ocean as it rushes

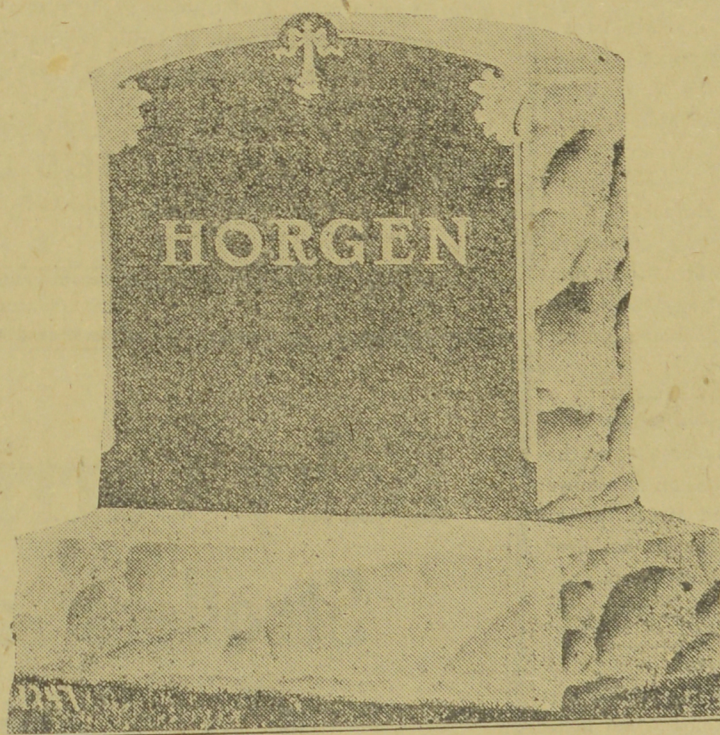
