Delicate Chocolate Blanc-Mange.

Sift together one-third cup corn-starch, one-fourth teaspoon of salt, one-third cup of sugor, dilute with one half-cup or cold milk, add slowly to two cups of milk that have been scalded in the duble-boiler. Cook over hot water minutes, stiring constantly until the mixture, thickens afterward occasion ally; melt one and one-half squares of chocolate over hot water, stir until smooth then add to the cooked mixture; fold in the whites three eggs beaten until stiff and add one teaspoon of vanilla. Turn into individual moulds that have been dipped into cold water and chill. Serve with sweetened cream whipped cream.


