



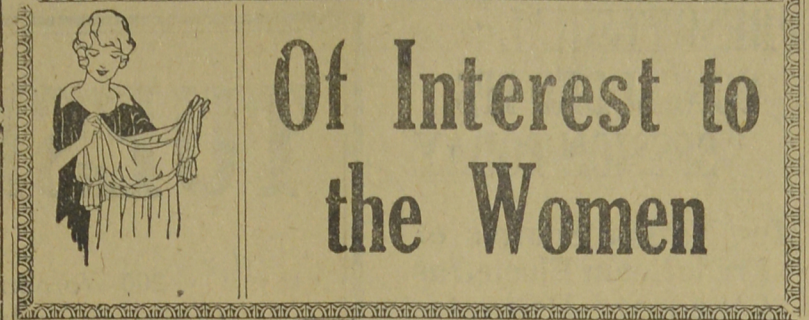

EVEN THE HANDKERCHIEF IS IMPORTANT.

Every frock must have its matching handkerchief this season and for this reason every conceivable shade of pastel handkerchief is being carried. The chartreuse green handkerchief of crepe de chine accompanies the chartreuse gown just as the rose frock is matched by a rose kerchief.

The many colored hat is one of the season's new offerings. Usually they are made of numerous pieces of oddly shaped silk fagoted together or they may be made of modernistic printed silk in odd design. Both turban and tam shapes are utilized for such bonnets.

The polka dot is decidedly in style this season. We see evidences of the dot in cotton as well as in silk materials. Irregular and scattered dots of small size are most in demand. Parasols, coat linings, frocks, scarfs, ties, jabots, lapels, hatbands and handkerchiefs are shown in polka dot designs in both small and medium dots.

The cape coat has but one opponent and that is the straight lined coat.

PINEAPPLE COCKTAIL.

One can pineapple, one orange one slice honeydew melon (yes, you can get them), one tablespoon sugar two tablespoons non-alcoholic French vermouth.

Cut the pineapple in small slivers peel and chop the orange into small pieces, cut the honeydew melon into bits about one-half an inch long, and divide the fruits thus prepared and serve in tall glasses. This should be about the amount for six to eight persons. Next pour the juice from the pineapple into a bowl and stir into it the sugar. Add the juice from the orange which possibly dripped from the fruit when it was being cut up and stir into this the French vermouth. Be sure that it is thoroughly blended and pour over the fruits in the glasses. If desired a cherry may be placed on the top of each with very pretty effect.

EGG AND GREEN SALAD.

All green things such as lettuce endive and dandelions which are coming to market should be arranged on the salad plate to form a nest. Hard boiled eggs chopped very fine and seasoned with salt, pepper, celery salt and about a teaspoonful of French dressing to an egg should be mixed and rolled into balls in the palm of the hand to form the eggs for the little nests. Over each individual salad pour a tablespoon of French dressing. Some of the eggs may be lightly dusted with paprika to give a variety of color others rolled in grated orange peel.

SPONGE CORN MUFFINS.

Cream one half cup of butter and gradually one cup of sugar alternately, with three eggs beaten until very thick and lemon tinted; add one cup of corn meal sifted with two cups of flour, two teaspoons of baking powder and one teaspoon of salt alternately with two cups of thick sour milk. Beat thoroughly and add one half teaspoon of soda dissolved

in a tablespoon of water; beat again and turn into well-greased gem cups filling them to one-third their depth. Bake in a hot oven twenty or twenty-five minutes.

INSURANCE EXCEEDS THE PACE OF 1925

New York May 18—New life insurance policies for the first four months of this year were 12.2 per cent greater than the same period last year, the Association of Life Insurance Presidents announced yesterday. The association is composed of 45 companies having in force \$1 per cent of the business done by all United States legal reserve companies.

Production for April was 7.4 per cent greater than for the past April's business amounting to \$966,000,000. This year's business for the first four months was given at \$3,694,000,000.

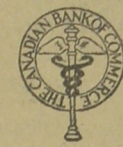
