Sift the flour and baking powder into bowl; add the shortening and rub in dightly; add just enough cold water to hold together; put into bowl in cold place for 3 or 4 hours, then roll out very thin. Put the butter in in small pieces, and double the dough; ro'l out again. Line 7-inch tin plate with the dough and fill with the cranberries. The remainder of the dough is rolled out, cut in very narrow stripes and placed criss-cross over the tart. Brush the strips with milk. Bake 25 minutes


