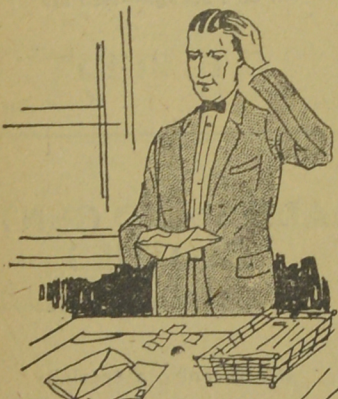

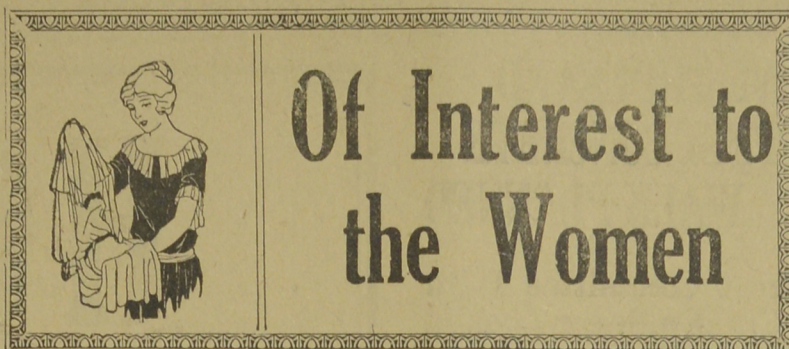

### HOUSEHOLD NOTES.

The wooden porch floor can be easily cleaned with a dustless floor mop.

The outer leaves of lettuce cooked with slices of raw carrots and an onion are quite fine.

The man who is working out of doors can eat heavier food than the man whose work is inside.

The heavy leaves of cauliflower boiled until tender then lifted out, will provide a good creamed soup.

In cooking spinach add no water. The small amount that adheres to the leaves while washing is sufficient.

To prevent the filling from soaking into the undercrust of a pie grease the crust with a little shortening.

### CHOCOLATE FROSTING.

One cup granulated sugar, 4 tablespoons cocoa, 5 tablespoons milk. Stir all together and cook in double boiler until it begins to thicken. Then add yolk of one egg and cook a little longer. Add vanilla and let it stand until it begins to

cool. Then beat and spread on cake.

This frosting does not need much attention while cooking and is always soft but does not "run."

### LEMON MERINGUE PIE.

Mix together 1 cup sugar, 3 tablespoons cornstarch and 1 cup cold water and bring gradually to a boil, stirring constantly. Cook for 3 minutes and add pinch of salt, 1 teaspoonful butter, grated rind of 1/2 a lemon and the beaten yolks of 2 eggs. D., of Knox Presbyterian Church, Guelph, Ontario, was elected tonight as Moderator of the Presbyterian Church in Canada at the fifty-second meeting of the General Assembly that opened here this evening. The election in some ways was one of the most remarkable and surprising that the Assembly has seen for many years.

Six men were nominated for this highest honor it is in the power of the Presbyterian Church to confer on her servants. These were: Principal D. J. Fraser of Montreal, Rev. Dr. A. J. MacGillivray, Guelph; Dr. Andrew Grant of Toronto, Dr. S. Banks Nelson of Hamilton, Dr. D. T. L. McKerrill, Toronto, and Rev. W. G. Brown of Red Deer, Alberta.

## DRUNKEN AUTO DRIVERS WILL BE SOAKED

London June 31—New laws for wives, bigger penalties for drunken motorists and severe punishments for various sorts of liars will all be incorporated in the legal system of England tomorrow when the greater part of the criminal justice, enacted last December, comes into force.

The minimum penalty of drunken joy riders will be four months imprisonment or a fine of £50. The licenses of those convicted will automatically be suspended for one year.

The new act abolishes the presumption that a wife who commits an offense in the presence of her husband does so under his coercion. In future a wife will have to prove coercion.

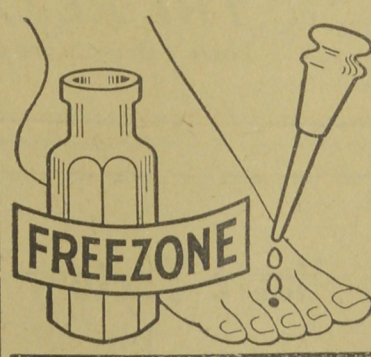
