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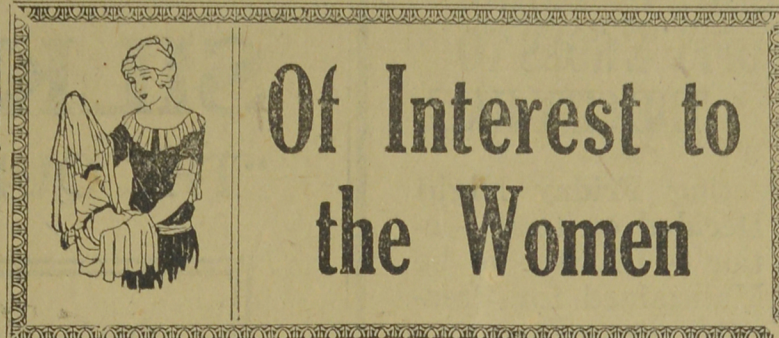
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Of Interest to the Women

The Best Corn Bread I Know.

1 cup flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1-2 teaspoon salt
1 egg
1 cup cornmeal
1 tablespoon sugar
1 cup milk
1-2 lb. bacon cut fine

Method—Sift dry ingredients; beat egg; add milk to mixture, spread thin in greased baking pan. Sprinkle bacon over top. Bake about fifteen minutes in a hot oven. If desired crisp brown in broiler.

SAND TARTS.

1-2 cup of solid shortening
1 cup brown sugar
1 egg
1 to 1 1-2 cups sifted flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1-4 teaspoon salt
1-2 cup sugar
3 teaspoons cinnamon

Method—Cream solid shortening; add sugar and cream again. Add unbeaten egg, mix well. Add flour which has been sifted with baking powder and salt. Roll to one-third inch thickness and cut in diamond shapes. Brush over top with beaten egg white and sprinkle with sugar and cinnamon which have been mixed together. Nuts or raisins may be placed on top. Bake fifteen minutes in a hot oven.

Five Minute Chocolate Frosting.

Place two divisions of a half-pound tablet of Chocolate-Mentor in a saucepan with one-half cup of fresh cream or one-fourth cup milk. Place over slow fire until chocolate is melted; boil for about a minute, stirring constantly. Take from fire stir for two or three minutes. Spread between layers and on top and sides.

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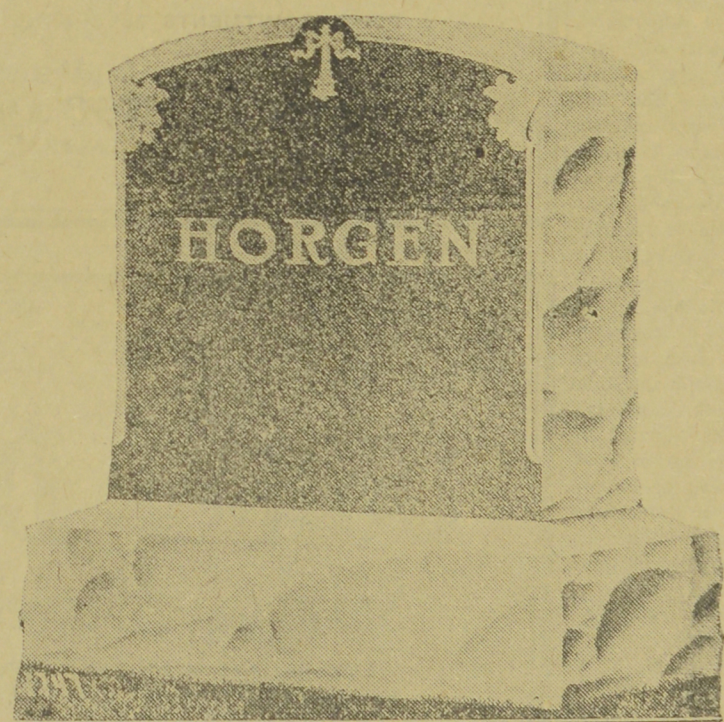
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The above design is polished on both sides. The top is hammered to a fine smooth finish with the edges nicely turned. The sides are rustic; that is rough broken surface with the edges carefully chamfered in hammered finish. The ornamentation on the corners is cut in light relief not just traced. The Initial of the family name can be cut in the apex instead of the little design shown. The prices quoted below are for the Monument Completely erected on a concrete foundation in Fredericton or vicinity. The sizes are for the diepiece or top stone and the bases are in proportion.
