Fredericton's Big Payers
Of Taxes for City Upkeep

F. B. Edgecombe in Position of Honor—Some
Heavy Payments by Companies, Firms and
Estates—Payments in Excess of \$150.

A list of the tax-bills of the City of Fredericton totalling \$150 or more follows. Some formidable bills are in the list. F. B. Edgecombe who for some years has the distinction of paying the largest bill is again at the head of the list. The two items for which Mr. Edgecombe is responsible are his own bill of \$1,686.84 and \$2,560.80 for the F. B. Edgecombe Co. making a total of \$4,247.64.

Other individuals paying heavy taxes are Mrs. J. O. Calder, \$2,640; H. G. Kitchen, \$1,969.26; A. J. Gregory, \$1,589.60; J. F. Vanbuskirk, \$1,200.92; W. W. Boyce, \$1,076.87; H. S. Campbell, \$1,000.80; W. E. Farrell, \$1,039.88; F. A. Good, \$1,004.24; Mrs. Eliza Jewett, \$1,001.52; The Misses Odell, \$1,009; G. Clark, \$973.88; Dr. J. W. Inches, \$950.40.

Companies and business firms also pay heavily. The first place is occupied by J. S. Neill & Sons Limited with \$3,867.60 and the Maritime Electric Co. second with \$3,696. Others paying big bills are J. Clark & Son Limited, \$3,087.45; R. Chestnut & Sons Limited, \$3,070.32; A. F. Randolph & Sons, \$2,803.68; New Brunswick Telephone Co., \$2,772; Kitchen Bros. Limited, \$2,455.20; Smith Foundry Co. Limited, \$1,214.40; J. J. Weddall & Son, \$1,056; Lemont & Sons, \$1,122; John Palmer & Co., \$1,052.80; J. C. Risteen Co., \$963.60.

Estates some of which hold real estate in considerable quantities also pay well to the city treasury. Among them are the following: James Hodge Estate \$1,768.80; Twinning Estate \$924; Owen Sharkey Estate \$1,056.50; F. I. Morrison Estate \$2,172.72.

The banks also pay in large amounts those owning real estate having the large bills. Bank of Montreal pays \$3,303.05, Bank of Nova Scotia \$2,043.35 and Royal Bank of Canada \$2,472.46.

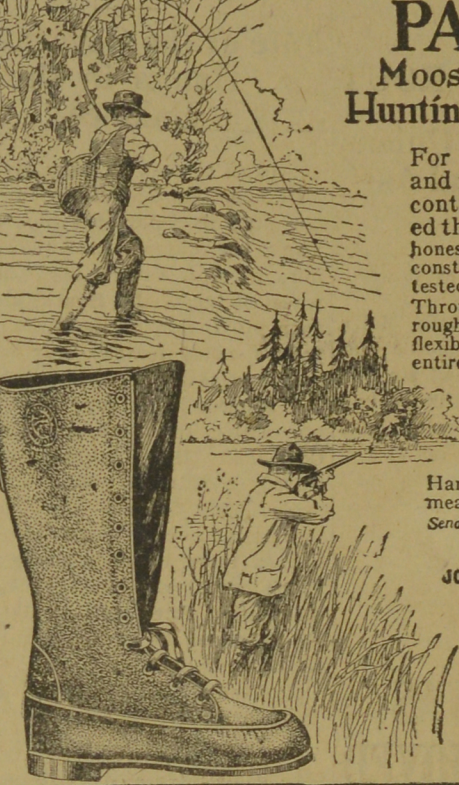
