## THE SPRING TAILLEUR.

Buttons and buckles must match on the spring tailleur. The two piece suit is good for the early spring as is also the two piece jumper and on these two the use of belts has been especially stressed in all of the Paris openings. Therefore belt buckles are receiving new interpretations. Tall oblong buckles are very smart and to match these are small buttons which as a rule appear down the front of the jumper or in the case of a suit, on the accompanying blouse. All sorts of metal are used for these matching buttons and buckles as well as mother of pearl, which is often carved in bas or high relief.

Again these mother of pearl buckles have been seen carved in the shape of animals' heads such as elephants, dogs and cats. A variation recently shown by a well known Parisian house was a wide leather belt which instead of a buckle, had an overlapping strap which slipped through two slits and in this manner formed the only fastening.

From belts to such prosaic things as nutcrackers is the next jump but with the advent of the latest kind of nutcracker prosaic is the last adjective that can be applied to this article. A novelty recently seen in a New York shop was in the shape of a solid silver animal. These are elephants, dogs and cats who harbor the real nutcracker in their mouths. These articles are placed upright on a table. A lever which extends up from the center of their backs when lowered and manipulates the jaws of the aforementioned animal.

The modern style of interior decoration is responsible for interesting pieces of furniture and what-nots which fascinate by their sheer boldness of color scheme. Some book shelves recently displayed had the outer part of the bookcase painted a dark green while the shelves themselves were of a brilliant vermilion. To accompany these there were a number of square soft cushions which were covered with hand blocked linen. Some of the cushions had different sides, on striking one having one side black while the other was of orange with large bold figures of black, the edges being piped in black.

Now that it is absolutely necessary for everything about the costume to match it appears that one must have one's handkerchief matching one's scarf. A prominent avenue shop is featuring these with large faces painted on in bright colors. The scarves are usually square and are to be worn knotted at the throat, while the handkerchiefs are to be placed in the vest pockets of these tailleurs of which we have spoken so often.

And by the way when looking for your tailleur remember that the newest ones have shirt and coat of different colors. A blue coat with gray shirt makes a very smart tailleur.

## HARD SAUCE.

For the making of a hard sauce of velvet smoothness, use confectioners' sugar and butter. This may be in the proportion of one part of butter to two of sugar. If a semi-liquid sauce is desired add a beaten egg to the hard sauce, flavor with vanilla.

—Ida M. Thomas in New York Sun.

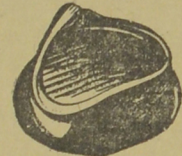

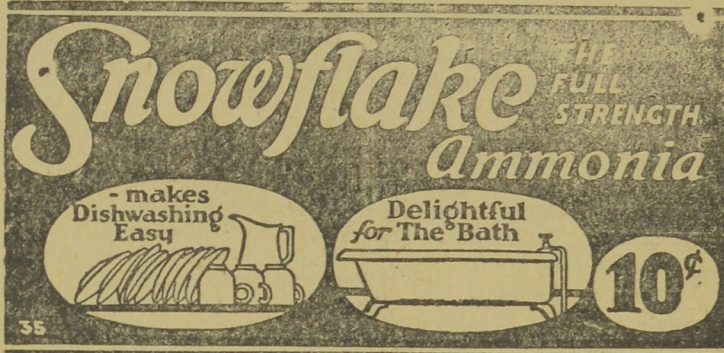

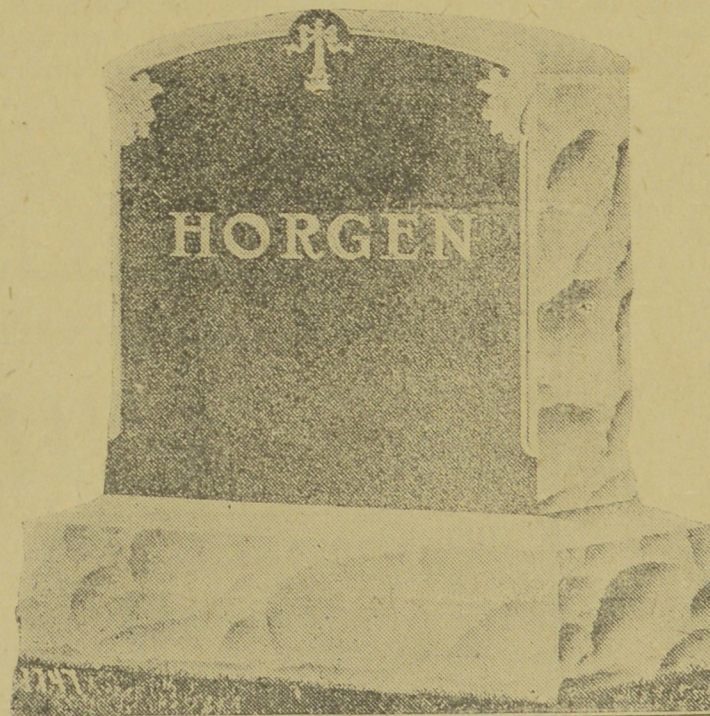
