Leaned Tristram and Iseult before York Sun.





Of Interest to the Women

SWEDISH RHUBARB CREAM.

1 1-2 cups rhubarb cut in pieces
1 pint of water
3-4 cup sugar
1-8 teaspoon salt
1 1-2 tablespoons cornstarch
1-2 teaspoon lemon juice

Cook the rhubarb, water, sugar and salt until the fruit is tender. Stir the cornstarch in an equal quantity of cold water and add, cooking until it is perfectly done. Add the lemon juice and turn into individual glass dishes. Sprinkle with a little sugar and serve with cream or milk.

BANANA PUDDING.

Three fourths cup sugar 3-4 cup sweet milk, yolks of 2 eggs, level tablespoon butter, rounding tablespoon flour.

Beat all together and cook until thick. Let cool and flavor with vanilla. Beat in whites of eggs until stiff then put a layer of graham crackers and a layer of sliced bananas in a dish and cover with the mixture above until it is used up.

RAISIN-NUT PIE.

1 1-4 cup raisins
Juice and grated rind 1 lemon
Juice and grated rind 1 orange
1-4 cups water
1-2 cup sugar
1 tablespoon flour
1 cup chopped English walnuts
Pastry for a two crust pie

Bring the water to boiling and add the raisins simmering until they are tender. Mix flour and sugar and add with the fruit juices and grated rind. Cook slowly until thick and add the chopped English walnuts. Bake in two crusts.

CREAM SAUCE.

Melt four tablespoons of butter in a saucepan. When melted and bubbling add three tablespoons of flour one half teaspoon of salt and one fourth teaspoon of pepper. Stir to a smooth paste and add slowly one cup each of warm milk and thin cream stirring constantly. Beat until smooth and glossy.

ALMOND COOKIES.

Mondelschnitzen or almond cookies are delicious. Blend 1-4 lb. powdered sugar 1-2 lb. butter 1 lb. flour, the yolks of 4 eggs and 3 tbsps. of cream. Roll out with sugar and flour 1-4 inch thick and cut into diamond shapes. Ice with yellow icing, stew with chopped and blanched almonds and set in the oven to dry.

TOMATOES AND ONIONS.

Two and one half cups canned tomatoes, 2 tsp. sugar, 1 tsp. salt 1-8 tsp. pepper, 1-2 tsp. curry powder. Butter casserole or glass baking dish. Put in one layer of tomatoes (with the juice strained off) and one of chopped onions until dish is filled. Cover with cracker or bread crumbs and a little bacon fat. Bake one hour.

Eggs In Potato Cases.

Cook sufficient potatoes and mash well. Season with salt, pepper and butter. Turn the potatoes out on a floured pastry board and pat into a

thin layer. Cut with a biscuit cutter and place the cakes on a buttered tin. Make a depression in the center of each one. Just before breakfast brush each potato case with milk and place in oven to dry. When hot and slightly browned remove from oven and drop an egg into each case. Sprinkle lightly with salt and pepper and place a small piece of butter on each egg. Bake in moderate oven—350 degrees—for 15 minutes until egg is set. Garnish with parsley or celery tips.

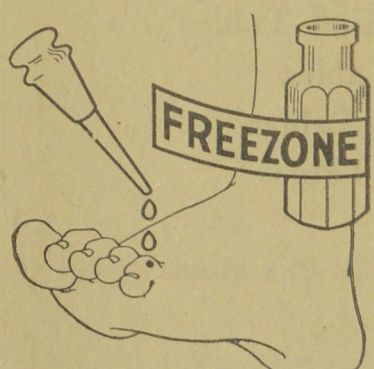

The best training school for waiters is one in Berlin. It was founded in 1892 and here dozens of pupils are being taught the art of laying the table, carving and serving faultlessly.

Due regard is paid to all the niceties of the art of serving which prescribes for instance that the edge of the plate must lie half an inch inside the edge of the table—no more and no less. The curriculum which requires about eight weeks, includes a short course of law as affecting hotel and restaurant keepers and their servants.
