With one exception those composing it were members of the late House, and took an active part in the drive which resulted in the downfall of the MacKenzie King administration. Every province in the Dominion is represented in the new cabinet with the exception of Saskatchewan, but the portfolio of Interior has been left vacant and will undoubtedly be given to a member for that province. Hon. E. L. Patenaude, a Quebec man who has taken the portfolio! of Minister of Justice, is the only minister who was not a member of the House recently dissolved. Hugh Guthrie, a former minister of militia meaning during the 15th Briand Cab and an able lawyer; and Hon. S. F. Tolmie, a former minister of agricul-

Forming a cabinet with a view of satisfying all sections and classes in a great country like Canada is not an easy task, but Premier Meighen seems to have made the best use of the material at his disposal and undoubtedly has a strong administration. Whe ther or not it will make good is of course a matter for the future to de-

The date of the election has not yet been announced, but it will likely be between the 15th and 21st of September. This will allow ample time to present the issues to the country. What Canada needs more than any thing else is stable government, with one or the other of the historic parties in actual control of Parliament.
