FRILLED COATS.

Many and varied are the uses of quilting just now. That old-fashioned treatment no longer is confined to "comfortables" and such things but is given to silks and satins, novelty linens and cottons destined for a more worldly existence. There are luxurious quilted satin boudoir robes, coatlike in silhouette, which are sometimes lined with a contrasting color and sometimes monotone, just the sort of thing for chilly mornings or nights in one's room and there are really smart sports coats of plain and novelty fabrics which are quilted and lightly padded. Quilted linings in fur coats and cloth ones are also noted in Paris and there are, as well, charming little quilted hats which the sometimes in patchwork effect, in several colors but always in the angular designs which we have learned to approve, thanks to the Cubist movement.

In many ways, coats at the moment present even greater interest than dresses. Heretofore it has been most unusual to find a coat made of contrasting materials. Now there are all manner of smart-looking novelty woolen combined, with plain ones which in the most literal sense, while appearing to be contrasted materials, are actually plain with bordered effects. Several of the newer coats have box pleated sides, or are entirely boxpleated from below the hip section, and joined to the top, by points of diamond shaped motifs of the cloth, often bound a coat with a shawl collar buttoned to one side, the material of the collar continuing in a godet at one side is very popular abroad.

HOUSEHOLD NOTES.

A slice of lemon makes tea more digestible than when milk is used.

When boiling fish do not allow it to cook rapidly or the flesh of the fish will break.

If a steak has much fat, remove part of it before boiling.

Cubes of tart jelly make an attractive garnish for the breakfast omelet.

Creamed oysters with mushrooms added are very palatable.

Salad vegetables are most healthful when dressed with oil and lemon juice.

Cream boiled ham, sliced and served in a border of hot scrambled eggs, is attractive.

Flour should be sifted with the baking powder when these two ingredients are used.

The tea kettle should never be quite full as water expands in heating, boils over and spoils the appearance of the stove.

Hot biscuits are better if kneaded throughout and allowed to rise a few minutes before baking.

Graham or whole wheat flour is better than white flour for buns that are made without eggs.

Doughnuts, potatoes and fritters can be fried in the same fat, providing the potatoes are fried first.

A few left-over mashed potatoes and a fragment of canned corn combined will make a delicate corn pudding.

The whiteness of white clothes and the cleanness of colored clothes depends greatly on thorough rinsing when laundering.

RAISIN BISCUIT.

2 cups flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1 teaspoon salt
1-2 cup seeded raisins
2 tablespoons shortening
1-2 cups milk
1 egg
1 tablespoon butter

Sift flour, baking powder and salt into bowl; add shortening and rub in very lightly. Beat eggs until light; add to the milk; then add to the flour and add the raisins. Drop on bakepan that has been dusted with flour (not too close together)

or bake in muffin tins. Put in hot oven and bake fifteen to eighteen minutes. Brush top with soft butter as soon as taken from oven.

Pineapple And Prune Marmalade.

2 cups grated or crushed pineapple
1 pound prunes
1 cup sugar
1 level teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon lemon juice
1 teaspoon grated lemon rind.
Wash the prunes and put into sauce-pan with cold water to cover and boil slowly until they will mash easily. Remove the stones and mash through coarse strainer or colander return to saucepan and add the grated or crushed pineapple, sugar and salt; boil slowly 40 minutes to 1 hour stirring frequently; add lemon juice, and rind. It must be thick enough to spread and not separate.

SPUD PRICES KEEPING UP FAIRLY WELL

Moncton, Feb. 17.—Potato prices are being well maintained and there is a steady demand in Havana, Cuba for the New Brunswick product, said F. L. Estabrooks, ex-M. L. A., of Sackville today, while in the city for the tubers landed in Saint John \$7 a barrel is being paid. Unfortunately the heavy snow has practically tied up deliveries and it is impossible to fill such orders at present, Mr. Estabrooks said. The risk that they would be stopped on the way is too great and the farmers in any case cannot get them to the railways over the heavy roads. He predicted that the net return to the farmers in this section of the province at least would be considerable in advance of that obtained for the 1924 crop which was marketed at this season last year.

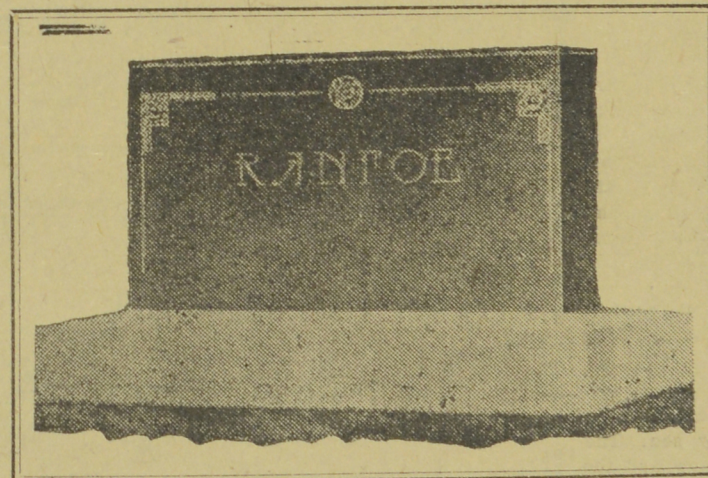
