SALMON SOUFFLE.

One can salmon, half a cup soft All the world's a stage, no doubt, bread crumbs, one fourth teaspoon But few can grasp the plot, teaspoon paprika, yolks of three All other lines just rot.

Clean one pint scallops, parboi and drain. Add juice of one lemon, cover and let stand one hour. Drain dry between towels, sprinkle with salt and pepper, dip in flour, egg and stale bread crumbs, fry in deep fat and drain on brown paper. Cool cut in halves, marinate with dress ing and serve garnished with sliced tomatoes and watercress.

### LEMON PARSLEY SAUCE

Four tablespoons butter, one table spoon of lemon juice, sait, cayenne and one tablespoon of chopped parsley. Cream butter, add lemon juice and seasonings slowly. Serve




