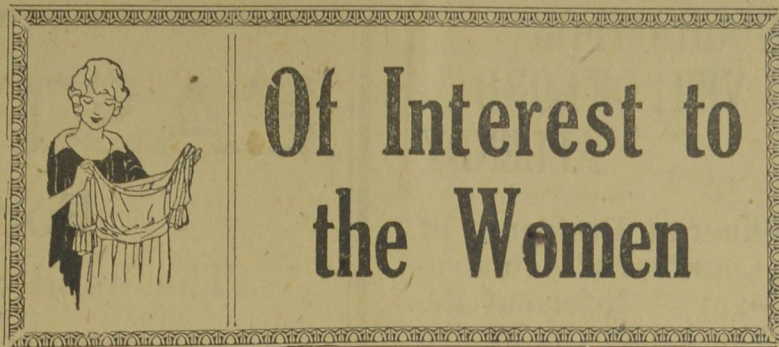

SIMPLE DRESSES FOR CHILDREN THE STYLE.

Little girls are deserving of more attention than is usually their portion with regard to clothes. Yet some of them—those who are born with a clothes sense—usually arise at a very early age to lay down the law with regard to what they do and do not think about the clothes that are to adorn them through their daily work and play.

To begin with, all children's clothes today are as simple as their elders clothes purport to be the only difference being that the clothes for the children usually get away with the simplicity better than some of the more grown-up ones do.

Plain bandings and bindings, rows of buttons and rows of braid stitching or hemstitching are the things that distinguish the dresses for tiny tots, and when these accents are done in interesting color combinations with the trimming there is apt to be the greatest amount of success.

The calico dresses are as bright and colorful as they can be and printed ones are trimmed with plain bands or edges of material just to bring out the beauty and color of their designs. Then there are the linen dresses. These are the ones that display the hemstitching most beautifully. And they are bright in color too, having the added value of washing most beautifully. They are apt to have collars and cuffs of white to set off their splashes of color and to give the proper tailored finish to keep them in style.

Party dresses of course are the delight of the children's lives, as they are of all beholders. They, too are plain but they are made of the finest of fabrics—chiffons and silks, voiles and mousselines. The silk ones and those of the heavier weights of chiffon are often adorned with hand embroidery, which, though it is not conspicuously handsome, does nevertheless carry a most decided air of richness with it. The point is that it is not too handsome for the littlest girl and still it gives her and her mother that sense of good dressing which every female no matter what her age, likes to carry about with her.

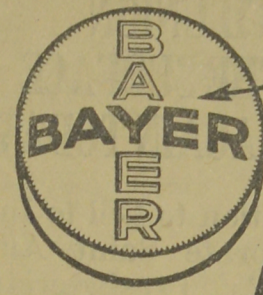

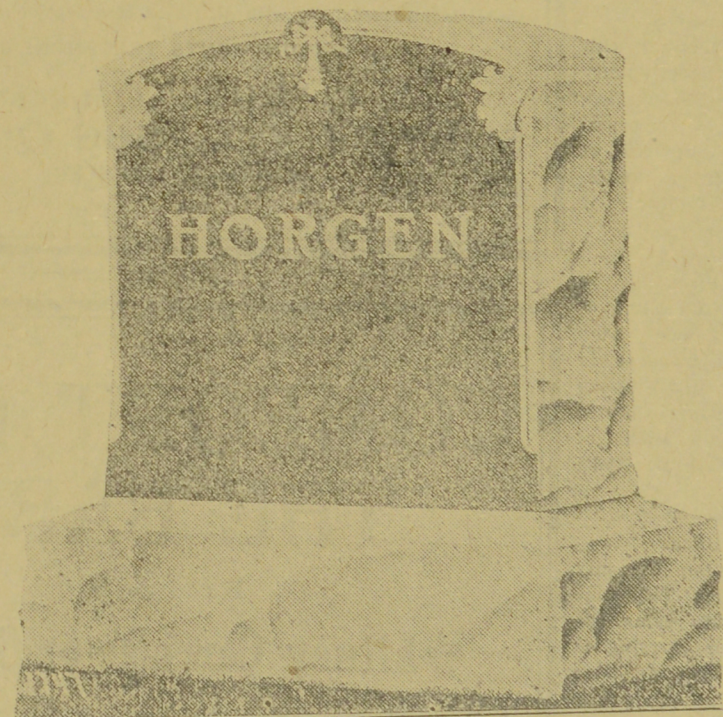
