Cream margarine, add sugar and egg yolks. Beat well. Flavor, mix Add just enough flour to make dry ingredients together and add to batter stiff enough to roll and cut. first mixture alternately with milk. Roll to one quarter inch thick. Cut Bake in two oiled layer pans seven by seven inches for 25 minutes at until a deep golden brown. Drain 375 deg. F.

- 1-2 cupful brown sugar
- 1 cupful sour milk 2 cupfuls cake flour
