Small Cucumber Pickles

The old fashioned way of doing cuumbers is to salt them down and pickle them a few at a time during the winter season. In many places this is still the habit, but the better way is to select the small cucumbers called gherkins, pickle them quickly and keep them in a glass jar.

Pickles Of Today

In these days we prefer to do our work more quickly so we hermetically seal things that we may be sure of keeping. Select small cucumbers, in fact quite tiny ones are best, wash and wipe them carefully. Put sufficent water in a granite kettle to cover the cucumbers. Bring to a boil take from the fire and add sufficent bit to make a brine that will float an egg. Pour this over the cucumbers. Let them stand twenty-four hours fully without bruising and place them in clean one quart jars. Put sufficient vinegar in a porcelain lined or granite kettle to cover them. Add one sliced onion, six whole cloves of garlic, one ounce of mustard seed three blades of mace to each fifty pickles. Let this come to a boiling point and pour it over the pickles. Add two tablespoonfuls of fresh grated horseradish, seal and stand aside to cool in the jars. They will be ready to use in two weeks and will keep all winter.


