### STRAWBERRY KISS PUFFS

Whites of six eggs

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon of vinegar 1 teaspoon of vanilla

Beat the eggs very light, fold sugar in gradually and add the vanilla and rinegar. Grease gem pans with lard or oil, as the salt in the butter makes the puffs stick. Put about two and a half taespoons of batter into each pan. Bake fifty minutes in a very slow oven.

When cool make a small hole in the top for each puff being careful not to break the delicate meringue. A sharp pointed paring knife cuts a neat triangular opening half an inch each way, which is large enough Crush one quart of strawberries mixed with one cup of sugar. Fill each cup with berries and put a tablespoon of whipped cream on each puff. Top with a whole strawberry or half an English walnut.
