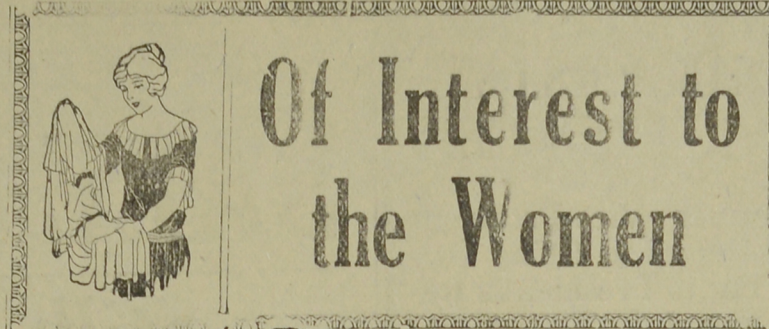

HOT WATER PIE CRUST

1-4 cup shortening
1-4 cup boiling water
Pinch salt
1 1-2 cups flour
1-4 teaspoon baking powder
Beat the hot water into the shortening until creamy then add the flour sifted with the salt and baking powder. Chill. Roll out on well floured board.

SWEET POTATO PUDDING

2 or 3 large sweet potatoes
1 quart milk
4 eggs
2 cups sugar
1 cup butter
1 teaspoon baking powder
Nutmeg
Pinch salt
Peel and grate the raw sweet potatoes. Cream butter and sugar. Add the well beaten egg yolks then milk, salt and baking powder. Into this stir the grated potatoes to make a stiff batter. Fold in the stiffly egg whites and nutmeg. Bake in a slow oven (300 degrees F.) one and half hours.

APPLE FRITTERS

Beat one egg without separating until light. Add a half cupful of milk; saltspoonful of salt and two thirds of a cupful of cake flour. When this is perfectly smooth, add a teaspoonful of baking powder and a cupful of chopped apples. Drop the mixture by spoonfuls into deep hot fat about 365 degrees Fahrenheit. When browned nicely on one side, turn and brown the other. Drain carefully and dust with powdered sugar.

MARSHMALLOW RICE PUDDING

3 cups cold boiled rice
1 cup milk
1 1-2 cups sugar
1 egg beaten
1 dozen marshmallows
Mix rice, milk, sugar and beaten egg and pour into a greased baking dish. Cover with the marshmallows which have soaked an hour in milk. Bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees F) twenty minutes. Serve with cream.

HOT POTATO SALAD WITH SAUSAGE.

Wash six medium sized potatoes and cook in boiling salted water until soft. Cool remove skins and cut in very thin slices. Cover the bottom of the baking dish with potatoes, season with salt and pepper, sprinkle with finely chopped parsley. Mix four tablespoons of vinegar and four tablespoons of olive oil and add one sliced lemon cut one third inch thick. Bring to boiling point pour over the potatoes, cover and let stand in the oven until thoroughly warm. Cover top with small cooked frankfurters or sausages.

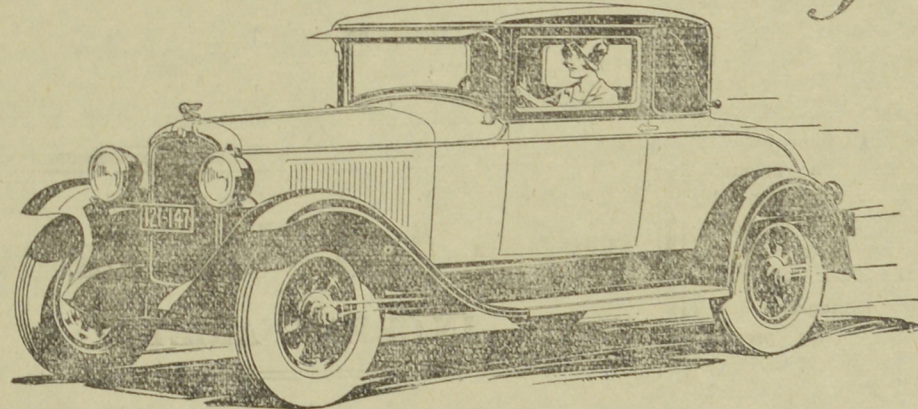
