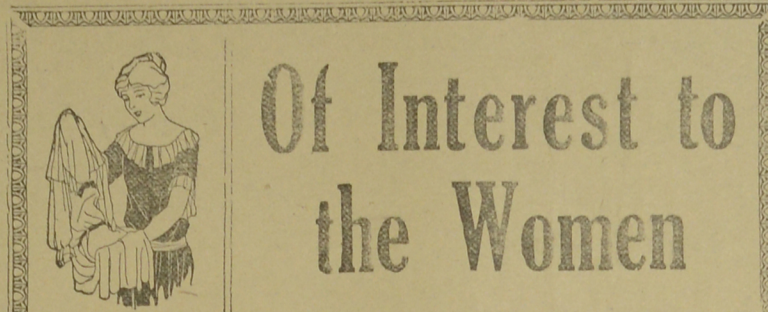

ORANGE AND RICE PUDDING

Pare oranges, cut in half crosswise and remove the membrane. Cook the halves in a syrup made from equal parts of sugar and water, to which a little lemon juice has been added, until they are tender but not broken. Place around a mound of boiled rice and pour the syrup over the whole. Serve with plain or whipped cream or a custard sauce.

FANCY DELIGHT COOKIES

One egg white beaten stiff. Fold into this 1 cup corn flakes, 1-4 cup sugar, 1-4 cup nuts. Drop by spoonfuls on a greased tin, and bake in a moderate oven. This makes 12.

DELICIOUS DESSERT.

Three oranges, 2 cups white cake, broken in small pieces, 1 cup heavy cream, 1 tablespoon sugar, 1-2 teaspoon vanilla, 3-4 cup almonds (toasted and ground). Peel oranges, remove all white membrane, and cut in small pieces, draining thoroughly combine with bits of cake and orange on mounds on individual dessert plates. 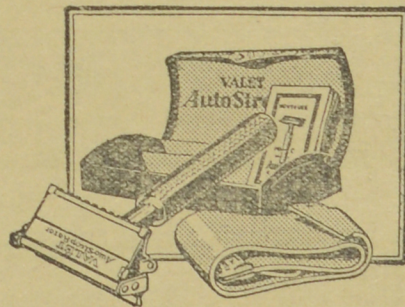
