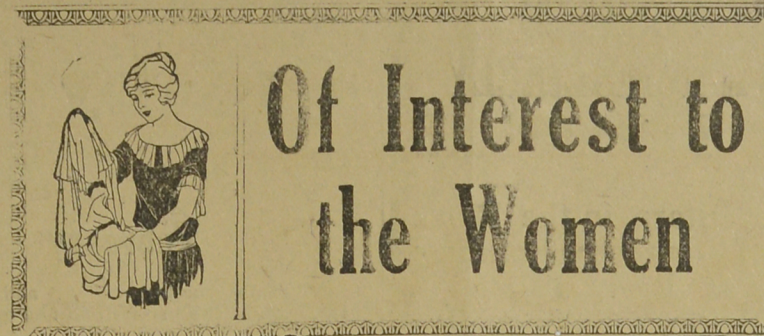

### HINTS TO HOUSEWIVES

Gingerbread made with coffee is delicious.

Keep soiled linen from bathroom in a closed hamper.

If the fern drops its fronds it is probably rootbound.

If the asparagus runs short, add rice. It is very nice.

Each kiddie should have his own laundry bag and use it.

Put raisins in boiled rice and the nutritious value is much increased.

Heavy cotton and linen suitings should be pressed on the wrong side or with a thin cloth spread over them.

A use for over boiled potatoes is to place them in a cloth squeeze hard mix with flour or barley meal and make into scones. They should be toasted and eaten with butter.

Don't throw celery tops away. Dry them in a cool oven keep in a covered jar and use for flavoring soups or gravies. When the flavor is strong enough drain out the leaves.

### SPICED RAISINS.

2 cups seeded raisins  
1-2 cup cider vinegar  
1 rounded teaspoon ground cinnamon  
1 teaspoon whole cloves or one quarter teaspoon of ground cloves.  
1 level teaspoon salt  
1-2 cup brown sugar  
1 teaspoon grated lemon rind  
Put the vinegar and spices on to boil; boil ten minutes; then add the well washed raisins; boil slowly fifteen minutes. Remove from fire and add the lemon rind. It may be necessary to add one quarter cup

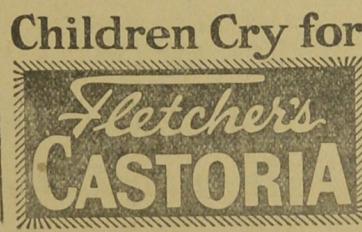

### PRUNE BUTTER.

2 pounds prunes  
1-2 pound brown sugar  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon cinnamon  
1-4 teaspoon grated nutmeg

Wash and soak the prunes overnight in enough cold water to cover put on to boil in the water in which they are soaked; boil slowly until tender (so they can be mashed through colander;) add the sugar salt and spices; boil slowly until thick. A little grated orange or lemon peel improves it.

### DRIED PEACH JAM.

1 pound dried peaches  
1 pound sugar  
1-2 teaspoon salt  
Wash the peaches through several waters; cover with boiling water. When cool remove skins; strain the water over the peaches then let stand twenty four hours. Put over fire and boil slowly in same water until tender; then mash fine and add the sugar and salt; boil until thick. This can be put in sterilized jars for future use.

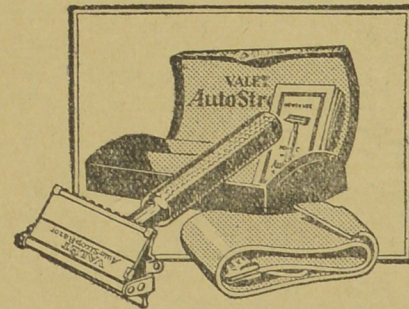
