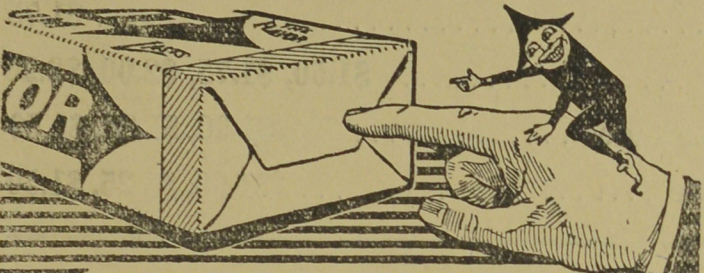

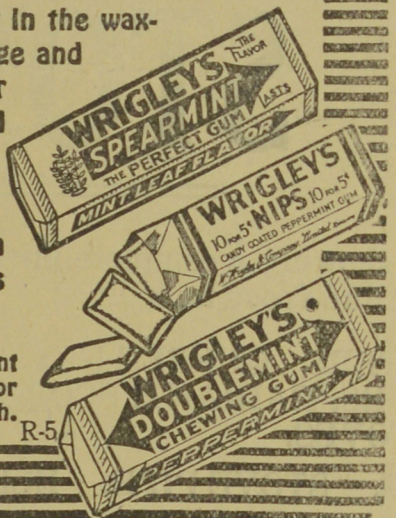

## Of Interest to the Women

### WOMAN'S COLUMN veem ody'ace QUINCE MARMALADE

12 nice apples  
4 pounds of sugar  
6 nice quinces  
1 lemon  
Core but do not pare the apples or quinces. Slice them put them into a kettle with water to half cover. Cover the kettle and cook slowly until the fruit is soft. Press through a colander, add the sugar and lemon juice and cook until you have a thick marmalade. Stir and watch carefully as it burns easily. This makes nice sweet sandwiches for school children.

### QUINCE AND APPLE RINGS

Pare four quinces and six apples and cut them into half inch slices crosswise. Cut or stamp out the cores; do not break the rings. Weigh and allow a quarter of a pound of apples and quinces. Put the rings using both kinds in large top quart jars add a portion of sugar to each jar and fill with boiling water. Seal half way stand the jars in a canning boiler of boiling water and boil after the first boil 10 minutes. Use these in the winter for ring fritters. They are nice for luncheon or as a sweet entremet for dinner.

### COCOA SPONGE CAKE ORANGE ICING

1 cup sugar  
1-2 cup cocoa  
1-2 cup water  
3 eggs  
1-4 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon cinnamon or flavoring to taste  
1-2 cup flour  
1 rounded or 2 level teaspoons baking powder

Put the sugar, cocoa and water into bowl, stir until the sugar is dissolved; add the yolks of eggs and cinnamon or flavor to taste and beat two minutes. Sift the flour baking powder and salt into mixture, add the stiffly beaten whites of eggs and fold in very carefully. Pour square pan which has been brushed with shortening and bottom covered with paper. Bake in moderate oven 45 to 50 minutes. Cover top with orange icing, made as follows:  
4 tablespoons orange juice  
1 teaspoon lemon juice  
XXXX sugar  
Mix the above ingredients using enough XXXX sugar to make a smooth paste. Spread over the top of cake and decorate with chopped candied orange peel.

### APPLE TART

1 cup flour  
3 tablespoons shortening  
Pinch of salt  
1-2 cup sugar  
6 apples  
1-2 teaspoon cinnamon  
Sift the flour and salt into bowl add the shortening and rub in very lightly with the tips of the fingers; add just enough cold water to hold together roll out on floured board a quarter inch thick and line pie plate.

Wash, pare, core and cut the apples into quarters if medium sized or into eight pieces if large apples. Place on the dough cut side down; sprinkle with the sugar and cinnamon. Bake in hot oven twenty minutes or until the apples are tender.

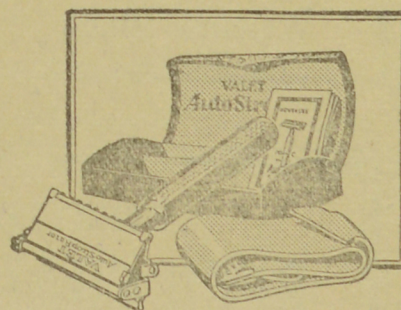
