The race is compulsory for all seniors. Any who shave the upper lip during the contest period risk a ducking the campus lily pond.

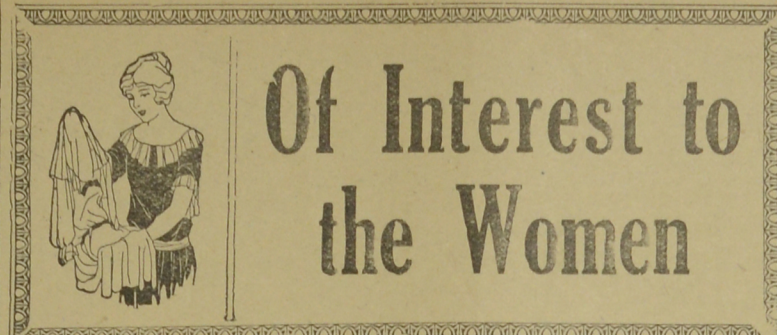
Two weeks from now the seniors will convene for official measurement, and to the man with the longest and most luxuriant mustache will go a suitably engraved shaving mug.

### ICE CREAM CAKE

Whip until stiff one cup of sweet cream, also the whites of three eggs, then combine them lightly and add to them half a cup of water and a teaspoon of vanilla. Have well sifted together two cups of pastry flour, three teaspoons of baking powder, one and one-half cups sugar and half a teaspoon of salt. Add this mixture a little at a time to the whipped cream and eggs; bake in two layers in a moderate oven about half an hour. Put together and ice with an icing made by slowly adding two cups of confectioner's sugar to six tablespoons of whipped cream into which has been stirred a fourth of a teaspoon of salt. Add one-half to a teaspoon of milk, drop at a time, and one-fourth of a teaspoon of vanilla. When the icing is just hardened cover with one and a half squares of chocolate melted over hot water.

### NEW ENGLAND MAPLE CAKE

Cream well half a cup of butter and half a cup of sugar; add two well beaten egg yolks and a cup of maple syrup; sift well two and a half cups of pastry flour, two and one-half teaspoons of baking powder, one teaspoon salt and a quarter of a teaspoon each of cinnamon and nutmeg. Add the dry ingredients to the egg mixture, beat well then add the well whipped egg whites. Bake in a greased and floured tube pan. Ice with maple frosting and put over the top and side halves of walnuts.

### ORANGE CAKE

Blend thoroughly two cups of sugar and the beaten yolks of five eggs, add half a cup of water, two and a half scant cups of flour, two level teaspoons of baking powder, the juice and grated rind of one orange and lastly the well-whipped whites of three eggs. Bake in layers and ice with the following: Boil two cups of sugar and six tablespoons of water until they spin a thread and add gradually to two well whipped egg whites. Add six marshmallows, cut up, the grated rind of one orange and one teaspoon of orange extract.

### BEST EVER CHOCOLATE CAKE

Melt in double boiler four squares of unsweetened chocolate, add one cup of sugar, one well beaten egg and half a cup of milk and cook until the mixture thickens, stirring; then cool. Blend well half a cup of butter and one cup of sugar and add two well beaten eggs, then two cups of pastry flour into which has been sifted two teaspoons of baking powder and half a teaspoon of salt; add half a cup of milk, adding the latter and flour alternately. When well-blended, add the chocolate and a teaspoon of vanilla. Bake in layers and ice.

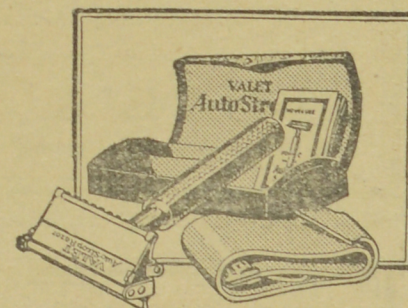
