BLACKBERRY ROLY POLY

- 3 cups blackberries
- 3-4 cup sugar
- 1 1-2 cups flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder 1-2 teaspoon salt 1 tablespoon shortening
- Milk

Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into bowl, add the shortening and rub in very lightly with the tips of the fingers; add enough milk to hold together. Roll out on floured board one quarter inch thick; cover with the blackberries and sugar; roll already? You told me you were going the same as jelly roll. Pour the mixture into bowl; set into pan of cold water and whip until it begins to form; then put into ice cream glasses and place 1 marshmallow on top.


