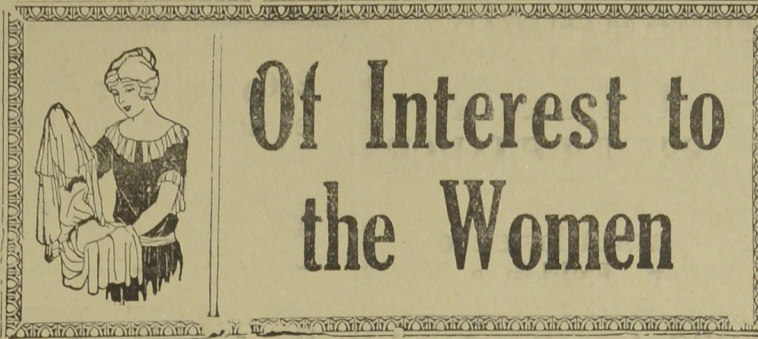

USEFUL HINTS TO KEEP IN MIND.

Chopped nuts mixed with a little honey make a tasty sandwich filler.

Stale cake will taste fresh if dipped in cold milk and rebaked in a hot oven.

When making peanut brittle add a pinch of salt and vanilla.

Fresh vegetables will retain the color if cooked uncovered in very little water.

Never wrap bread in cloth, as it absorbs the moisture.

French dressing should be applied to lettuce at the table so it may be served crisp and cold.

Scoop out the centers of apples, stuff with cranberries and bake them.

Two quarts of filling is required for a 10 pound turkey.

Grilled parsnips make a delicious garnish for broiled steaks.

DATE AND CHEESE SALAD

Stone the dates and refill with a mixture of cream cheese and salted peanuts. To serve six, allow twenty four dates, one package cheese and one quarter cup chopped nuts. Sprinkle with paprika and arrange in a lettuce cup with a spoonful of mayonnaise in the center. Garnish with whole salted peanuts.

ORANGE CAKE

5 egg yolks
1 1/2 cups sugar
1 orange juice and rind
2 cups flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
3 egg whites
1-2 cup hot water
Beat the yolks until lemon colored. Add the sugar gradually. Beat thoroughly, then add the hot water and orange juice and rind. Add the flour mixed with the baking powder. Lastly fold in the beaten egg whites. Bake in layers in a moderate oven. This may be put together with an orange cream filling.

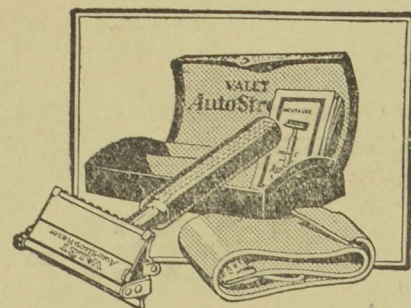
