B. C. LIQUOR PROFITS

British Columbia municipalities and other interests received a handsome Christmas box in the shape of their share of the liquor store profits for the half-year ending September 30 amounting in all to \$1,804,736. During the previous half-year profits of \$1,913,872 were similiarly distributed. The profits for the whole year so distributed were \$3,718,318, easily the highest on record. This last semi-annual distribution was as follows: Municipalities, \$482,323; mothers' pensions \$307.861; hospitals, \$210,995; revenue, \$703,318.
