- 4 teaspoons baking powder 4 tablespoons fat
- 2-3 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 6 medium sized apples 6 tablespoons sugar
- 6 teaspoons butter Cinnamon

Mix flour, baking powder and salt that can be rolled. Roll out to about one fourth inch in thickness. Cut in squares about six inches and place one peeled and cored apple on each square. Add one tablespoon of sugar one teaspoon of butter and a sprinkling of cinnamon to each apple. Fold the dough over the apple and place in a buttered pan or baking dish prevalent.




