

RESULT OF MATRICULATION
AND HIGH SCHOOL LEAVING
EXAMINATIONS MADE PUBLIC

The Board of Examiners for the Matriculation and High School Leaving Examinations held in July 1928 report four hundred and twenty-six (426) candidates for Matriculation and one hundred and three (103) for the Leaving Examinations.

Of the Matriculants thirty (30) passed in First, two hundred and twenty-seven (227) in the Second, seventy-three (73) in the Third, seventy-nine (79) in the Third Division Conditionally, and seventeen (17) failed to pass in any Division.

Of the High School Leaving Candidates, one (1) passed in First Division, fifty-five (55) in Second Division, nineteen (19) in the Third Division, twenty-four (24) in the Third Division Conditionally, and four (4) failed.

Pass Standard for First Division seventy-five per cent. of the aggregate marks obtainable, with not less than 50 per cent. of possible marks in each subject: for Second Division, fifty per cent. of possible aggregate marks with not less than one third of possible marks in each subject.
