## THREE YOUTHS DROWNED IN THE PETITCODIAC

### Triple Drowning in the River Near Moncton When Boat Was Swamped.

Moncton, N. B., June 12—A drowning tragedy which took the lives of three young boys, occurred on the Petitcodiac River, near Moncton late this afternoon. The victims of the fatality are Albenie Boucher, 15-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Lucien Boucher, Queen street East; Albert LeBlanc, aged 14, son of Mrs. Wilfred LeBlanc, a widow, residing in Main street; and Arthur Leger, aged 15 years, son of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Leger, Robinson street.

A fourth boy, Lewis LeBlanc, is the only survivor of the fatality, which took place about 4.30 o'clock this afternoon, and he is in the hospital suffering from shock and exhaustion, but is expected to recover.

It appears that the four lads set out from a point near the bore park in a frail row boat, upon which they had placed an improvised sail, shortly after the tidal bore had come up the Petitcodiac River. When they passed the Melvin Forbes wharf, some distance up, Wilfred Crossman and some other boys who were playing in that vicinity saw the boat rocking heavily, and shouted to the lads that they had better get into shore or they would be drowned. Whether they heard the warning is not known, for they continued on their course up the river.

Upon nearing the Moncton bridge, connecting this city with Albert county, the frail craft apparently got swamped by the heavy current then running, and a wave was seen later to strike it and turn it over, throwing the boys out.

#### Clung to Craft

Lewis LeBlanc, the survivor, and Albenie Boucher managed to cling to the upturned craft but the other boys, apparently realizing their peril, endeavored to swim to the north bank of the river. With the tide running strongly up river and facing a north-

## STARS TOLD CHANG TO GET OUT OF PEKIN

Pekin, June 12—Soothsayers probably played a part in the decision of Marshal Chang Tso-lin to abandon Pekin to the Nationalists. Chang retains much of the ancient Chinese belief in the powers of heavenly signs to direct human affairs.

Members of his entourage said two astrologers gained an influence on him that recalled the power of their prototypes in the camps of the Greeks before Troy, whose divinations were recorded in detail by Homer.

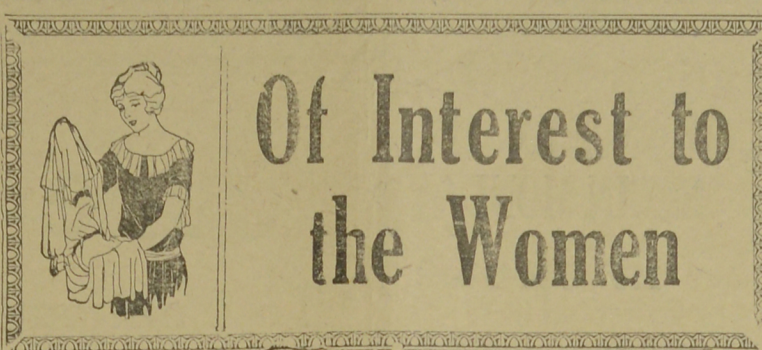
One of the Chinese astrologers goes under the professional name of Great Benevolence. He is a seventy-seven year old Buddhist monk from Honan Province, and the reputation he enjoyed there caused him to be summoned to Chang's court. His confere is known as Iron Mouth, a name chosen to signify that his words are dependable as that metal.

Iron Mouth, when Pekin was rejoicing over victories in Honan in the spring of 1927, predicted that misfortune was imminent. Almost on the day named came the defeat which caused the Northern retreat from south of the Yellow River a year ago. Not until the astrologers had pronounced the signs favorable did Marshal Chang take up his residence in the Presidential palace in June, 1927. Upon the advice of Great Benevolence he assumed office as a purely military dictator, rejecting proposals to make him President.

It was said that Chang's decision as to whether he would remain in Pekin or retire to his former base at Mukden would depend as much upon the findings of the soothsayers as on the pressure of the Nationalist armies, and many think it did.

### USEFUL HINTS TO KEEP IN MIND

### PRUNE WHIP

1-2 pound of prunes  
1-2 cup of sugar  
1-2teaspoon vanilla  
Whites of 5 eggs

Stew the prunes in a little water until very tender. Then stone them and mash skins and all to a fine pulp. Add the sugar and vanilla and mix thoroughly. Beat the whites of the eggs to a stiff froth. Then fold in the prune mixture very lightly. Bake in a dish set in a pan of hot water in a moderate oven (325 degrees Fahrenheit) for 30 minutes. Serve cold with soft custard or whipped cream. This recipe serves six persons.

### GRAPE JUICE LEMONADE

Four lemons, 1 pint grape juice 1 1-2 pints of water, 1 cup sugar. Place a small block of ice in a pitcher. Mix lemon juice, sugar water, and grape juice. Pour into pitcher and stir thoroughly. Allow to stand a few minutes before serving. Serves 6 persons.

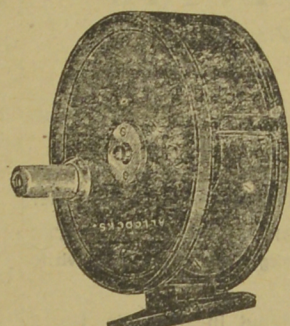
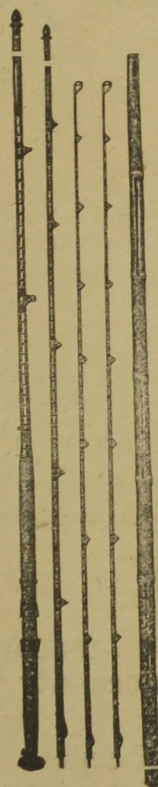

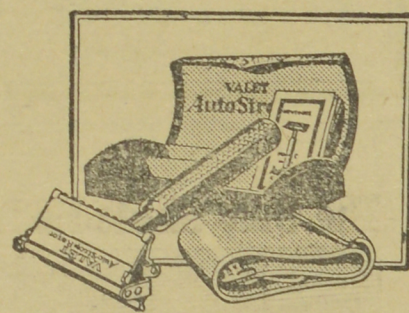
