PUMPS REMAIN
IN GOOD STYLE

If you wonder whether pumps are in good style for this season—you'll find they are. Perfectly plain pumps in the seamless style are ch'ce in black suede, and black or gunmetal calf, for they can be worn to accent the ensemble in the subtle undertones, such as the grape purples, the autumn blues, and the rich, dark reds.

FIG PUDDING

- 1 pint stale crumbs
- 1 pint hot milk
- 2 eggs
- 1-2 cup suet
- 5 tablespoons sugar
- 1 cup figs, chopped
- Steam three hours

HOLIDAY PUDDING

- 4 eggs
- 4 tablespoons sugar
- 1 quart milk
- 1-2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1-4 teaspoon salt
- 6 Boston crackers, split and buttered
- 1 cup raisins
- Place in an oiled mould. Let stand one hour and then bake three quarters of an hour at 325 degrees F.

BAVARIAN PUDDING SAUCE

- 1 pint milk
- 1 egg
- 1-2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon cornstarch
- 1-4 teaspoon vanilla
- Cook in double boiler until it is the consistency of thick cream

CREAM SAUCE

- 1-2 cup butter
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1-2 cup cream
- Few drops vanilla
- Stir over hot water until creamy

LEMON SAUCE

- 1 cup water
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- Boil water, sugar and cornstarch mixed with little cold water. Boil five minutes and add fruit juice.

FRUIT SAUCE

- 1-5 cup butter
- 1 cup canned fruit drained from syrup
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- White of 1 egg
- Cream butter, add sugar gradually, add egg beaten until stiff and beat well, add slowly fruit which has been carefully prepared and mashed. Beat until creamy.

CARAMEL SAUCE

- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 teaspoon butter
- Melt sugar in saucepan and heat stirring constantly until golden brown, add boiling water. Cook three minutes and add butter.

CHOCOLATE SAUCE

- 1 ounce unsweetened chocolate
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1-2 cup boiling water
- 1-2 cup sugar
- 1-2 teaspoon vanilla extract

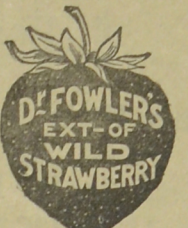
