Brush dough with water, place one and a half teaspoons of jelly on half of the dough three or four inches apart. Fold the second half over the first. Cut out with a round cookie cutter and let rise until light or double in bulk. Fry in deep fat until brown. Drain on unglazed paper and roll in a mixture of powdered sugar and cinnamon

SQUASH DOUGHNUTS

- 1-2 cup mashed and sifted squash
- 3-4 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons corn oil
- 1-4 cup sweet milk 2 well beaten eggs
- Pinch salt
- 1-8 teaspoon mace
- 2 1-4 cups flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder

Mix squash, sugar, oil, milk and eggs together. Sift and mix salt, mace, flour and baking powder together. Mix into liquid. The dough should be very soft. Roll a small amount at a time. Fry in oil 375 degrees F. for three minutes.
