FRASER OUTLOOK APPEARS BRIGHT FOR NEXT YEAR

Montreal Oct. 16—With the new board machine at Madawaska, one of the largest in the world in operation and production from the catalogue paper machine at Edmundston starting in the near future, Fraser Companies, Limited, appear to have partially rounded out the greater part of their development programme which was financed some months ago.

The large addition in the plants has resulted in an all round increase in efficiency, a lowering operating costs, and the creation of a greater earning power.

Predictions of earnings in the neighborhood of \$5 a share were made some time ago, and results to the present time are understood to fully justify these forecasts.

Moreover the company has secured a large interest in the Rolland Company, the leading producer of fine papers, operating exclusively in Quebec.

Construction of a \$2,500,000 bleached sulphite pulp mill will be commenced this month by Fraser Companies, Limited, at Athol, a suburb of Campbellton, N. B.

Arrangements have been made for the concrete foundations to be laid and completed this fall in readiness for the steel structural construction in the early spring. In this way construction of the new mill at Athol will proceed simultaneously with the new newsprint plant for International Paper Company at Dalhousie, which is also on Bay Chaleur, fifteen miles from here.

Fraser Companies' new mill will have a daily capacity of 150 tons and will require about 100,000 cords of pulpwood annually as supply of raw material. It is expected that at least 250 men will be given continuous employment and the main mill, comprising conveyors, digesters and power plant are to be completed next year so that operation may be commenced before the close of 1929.

COUPLE WERE MARRIED BY TELEVISION

Fraser Companies now have two large saw mills at Athol and the site selected for the pulp mill is on a plateau between the two saw mills. The location is such that pulpwood supplies may be brought direct by water from the Restigouche River as well as from the Gaspé Peninsula, Quebec.

The outlook for Fraser Companies is bright, especially in view of the fact that the full effectiveness of this year's expansion will really make itself felt, as far as earnings are concerned, in 1929.

BOBBED HAIR STILL IN VOGUE

MY NEIGHBOR SAYS

Apply with a woolen cloth, then rub briskly with a clean dry piece of flannel.

To make a faded garment white it should be washed in boiling cream of tartar water, allowing a teaspoon of the powder to a quart of water.

When making tomato salad scrape the skins of tomatoes with the back of a silver knife instead of covering them with hot water to remove the skins. Tomatoes will not then be soft but quite firm.

If you wish to set the colors in embroidered handkerchiefs soak them before washing for 10 minutes in a pail of water into which a dessert spoon of turpentine has been stirred.

When preparing bread crumbs for escalloped dishes, croquettes, etc., tie a cloth or paper bag over the mouth of the meat grinder and put the bread in. When the grinder is turned the crumbs will then be deposited in the bag instead of being scattered over the floor.

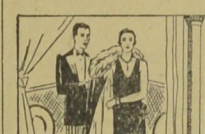
CHICKEN AND HAM FILLING

2 cups minced chicken
1 cup minced ham
1-2 a red pepper, minced
1 teaspoon minced white celery leaves
Salt, pepper
Chopped onion to taste
Minced sharp gherkin pickle
Mayonnaise to spread.
This mixture is nice on white or whole wheat bread. Wherever a mayonnaise filling is used, little or no butter is required.

COOKED CHEESE FILLING

1 tablespoon butter
1-2 a green pepper, minced
2 tablespoons chopped onion
1-4 teaspoon salt
1-2 cup strained tomato pulp or canned tomato soup
3-4 pound milk cheese
Few grains cayenne
1 egg
Milk or cream
Saute pepper and onion four minutes in butter. Add tomato and cook five minutes. Add cheese, put through food chopper and seasonings stir occasionally and cook in double boiler until cheese is melted, then add the egg, slightly beaten and mixed with two tablespoons thin cream or milk. Spread on lettuce leaves laid between slices of bread. An especial favorite with men.

SCOTCH SANDWICH

1 package cream cheese
3 tablespoons mayonnaise
1 cup finely shredded celery
1 teaspoon chopped onion
1-2 green pepper, chopped
Mix well and use with lettuce between slices of buttered or unbuttered whole wheat bread or on crackers.

CHEESE AND CHIVE SANDWICH

1 small cream cheese
1 teaspoon soft butter
1 tablespoon sharp mayonnaise or boiled dressing
1 tablespoon chopped nuts
1 tablespoon chopped chives
1 teaspoon sugar
Paprika
Mix all thoroughly, adding a little sweet cream if not moist enough. Spread whole wheat rounds with mixture using a small lettuce leaf with each sandwich.

MIDNIGHT SANDWICH

1 pound ground beef
1 small green pepper
1 medium onion
1 teaspoon flour
1-2 pint strained tomatoes
1 tablespoon butter
Mix pepper and onion, add to meat and brown in butter. Season to taste and add flour and tomato sauce. Place in buttered sandwich buns and warm buns in oven.

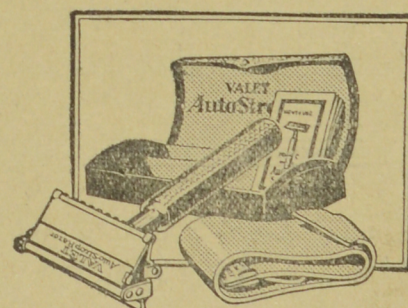
