


Rice Pudding

Here's a Tastier Recipe

1 cup boiled rice 1 teaspoon vanilla
 ½ cup Eagle Brand 1 egg
 Condensed Milk ½ cup water
 ½ teaspoon nutmeg

Mix Eagle Brand and water together thoroughly. Beat egg and blend with the milk and vanilla. Add this mixture to the rice (boiled) and mix well. Pour into buttered pan and sprinkle top with the nutmeg. Place pan in a dish of water (as for a custard) and bake in a slow oven until a golden brown.

Serve hot or cold.

LINGERIE HAS LACE TRIMMING

The shop windows this season reveal a preponderance of lace on present day lingerie. Most of this lace is of the ecru or bisque variety, although white Valenciennes is by no means to be despised. Usually the background is pink, satin or georgette. Occasionally a shade of raspberry is chosen for combinations with lace incrustations. For tea gowns, salmon and ecru is a favored combination.

CLEAN SHADES

Window shades should be cleaned each fall. Lay them flat, wipe off with a cloth dipped in a mixture of one pint of hot water and three tablespoonfuls of benzine. Dry by wiping with another cloth.

THE FUR COAT ENSEMBLE

Something very new in the field of clothes consists of a short fur coat with a frock to wear underneath it. One of the most charming and youthful models has a white fur coat and a very smart black dress with small collar and cuffs of white glazed linen. The coat is lined with the material of the dress and the whole affair is delightfully swaggy. Another combination consists of a frock of red and a black fur coat lined with red.

HOUSEHOLD HINTS

A few drops of lemon juice added to the water in which glassware is rinsed will give luster to it.

To remove grease from a sink sprinkle generously with a cleaning powder, then wipe off with a newspaper or soft paper. Grease will not then be washed down the drain-pipe.

Instead of warming roast beef over in gravy try putting it on a small tin pie plate and placing it in a steamer over boiling water. In about half an hour you have a fresh juicy roast.

CHEESE BISCUIT

2 cups flour
 2 teaspoons baking powder
 1 teaspoon salt
 1 cup grated American cheese
 3-4 cup milk
 1-2 teaspoon paprika
 Sift flour, baking powder, salt in bowl; add cheese and mix very lightly add milk; roll out half inch thick, cut with small cutter, brush top with milk and sprinkle with a little cheese and dust with paprika. Put in hot oven and bake 15 to 20 minutes. This amount makes sixteen biscuits.

BREADCRUMB GRIDDLE CAKES

1 cup breadcrumbs
 1 1-4 cup flour
 1 cup milk
 1 egg
 1 tablespoon molasses
 1 tablespoon melted shortening
 3 teaspoons baking powder
 1-2 teaspoon salt
 Cover the breadcrumbs with the cold milk for 10 minutes; then add the salt well beaten egg and mix well. Sift the flour and baking powder and add with the molasses and melted shortening, mix well. Bake on hot griddle until nicely browned on both sides. This batter must be quite thin.


SALLY LUNN

1 cup flour
 1 teaspoon baking powder
 1-2 teaspoon salt
 1 tablespoon melted butter substitute
 1 tablespoon sugar
 3-4 cup milk
 1 egg
 Sift the flour, baking powder, salt and sugar into a bowl; add the milk well beaten egg and butter; mix well. Brush square pan or large pie tin with butter substitute, pour in the mixture and bake 20 minutes in moderate oven. Heat knife before cutting the sally lunn. All hot bread must be cut with a warm knife.


