#### VANILLA COCOANUT KISSES

2 pounds fondant

1-4 pound (2-3 cup) fine cocoanut 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Follow remelting instructions When fondant is beginning to thin down add extract and then desiccated cocoanut. (This is the dry, shredded cocoanut). When fondant is thoroughly remelted spoon out uniform amounts using teaspoon, on waxed paper. Slice candy off the spoon using the handle of the spoon and keeping gloss on top. Do not turn spoon over, as the gloss will

#### CHOCOLATE FUDGE

- 2 pounds fondant
- 6 tablespoons melted bitter choco
- 3 tablespoons warm water
- 2 teaspoons corn syrup
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 2 tablespoons melted butter

Place the fondant in upper con ainer of double boiler or a shallow pan over boiling water. When fondant begins to thin add water, melted chocolate, butter, corn syrup and flavor. Mix thoroughly and pour in pan lined with paraffin or heavy waxed paper. Mark in squares while still warm.

### MAPLE PECAN KISSES

2 pounds fondant

1-2 teaspoon maple extract 2-3 cup coarsely broken pecans

Follow remelting instructions When fondant begins to thin add nuts and flavor. No coloring is necessary when using maple as this will color the fondant itself. Spoon out on waxed paper.

#### PINEAPPLE BAVARIAN CREAM

- tablespoons granulated gelatine
- 1-2 cup cold water
- 1 can grated pineapple 1-2 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1-2 pint cream

Soak gelatine in cold water. Heat pineapple, add sugar, lemon juice and soaked gelatine; chill in pan of ice water stirring constantly; when it begins to thicken, fold in cream beaten until stiff, mould and
